BETWEEN LESLIE JAMES HOLLYMAN (hereinafter called "the Grantor") of the one part

A N D TASMAN DISTRICT COUNCIL (hereinafter called "the Grantee") of the other part

WHEREAS:

- A. The Grantor is registered as proprietor of all the land comprised in Certificate of Title 12C/1117 (Nelson Registry) (hereinafter called "the servient tenement")
- B. The Grantee is registered as proprietor of all the land comprised in Certificate of Title 12C/1116 (Nelson Registry) (hereinafter called "the dominant tenement")
- C. The parties hereto have agreed that the Grantor shall grant to the Grantee a fencing covenant, along the boundary between the dominant tenement and the servient tenement.


NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the premises the Grantor (together with his successors in title) hereby covenants with the Grantee (together with its successors in title) that he shall not call upon the Grantee to make any contribution toward the cost of erecting or maintaining a fence line along the boundary between the dominant tenement and the servient tenement.

The Grantor further covenants with the Grantee that he will cause the within land covenant to be registered upon the title of the servient tenement.

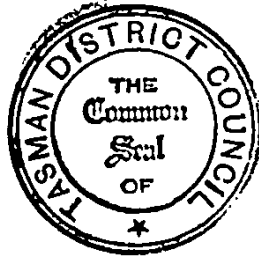


