

BLOOD SPILL EXAM SCRIPT

General Information and Setup

On behalf of National Testing Network we welcome you to your blood spill exam. Here are some basic rules.

- To remain in this exam, you must follow exam rules.
- No food, beverages or smoking are allowed.
- No talking is allowed.
- You need permission to leave the testing area.
- The exam timer does NOT STOP if you leave your station.
- Your stool, your kit and your disposal receptacles must be on the floor and underneath your assigned work station.
- Make sure your product labels are facing the evaluator so they can be easily read.

During the entire exam, you are being evaluated on personal and client safety, sanitation and infection control procedures. That includes maintaining cleanliness and strict sanitation while you work and sanitizing your hands at any point during the exam.

In a few minutes you will be told to begin setting up your workstation. After you hear the start tone, you will have 5 minutes, with a reminder when you have 1 minute left. Do not start until you are told to begin. This 5 minute setup includes your mannequin . . . your waste disposal receptacles. . your disinfectant...your blood spill kit . . . and any other *general* workstation items that you wish to take out. You should have plenty of time to perform this setup without rushing.

Your 5 minutes begin now. **(Tone)**

(Tone) 1 minute

(Tone) Time's up, stop working.

BLOOD SPILL EXAM SCRIPT

Blood Spill Procedures Demonstration

Introduction:

This is your blood spill procedures demonstration. After the start tone, you will have 10 minutes to demonstrate blood spill procedure on the forehead or hand of your mannequin following universal precautions.

Your 10 minutes begin now. **(Tone)**

(Tone) 3 minutes

(Tone) Time's up, stop working.

Completely clear, clean up and disinfect your area. That includes packaging all garbage to take with you. You may not leave disposable materials or anything else in the facility. When you are ready to leave, stand back and raise your hand. An evaluator will check your area and release you to leave.
