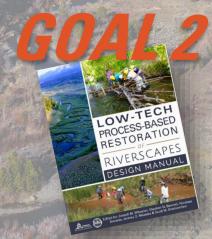

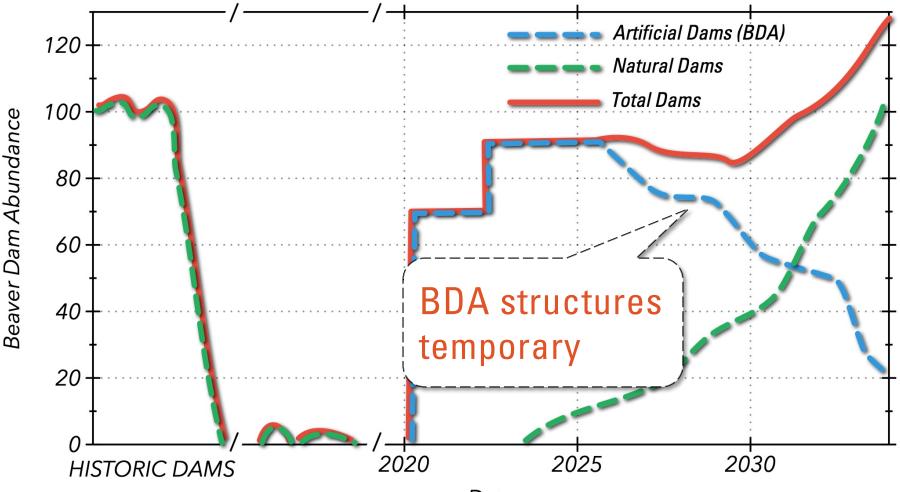




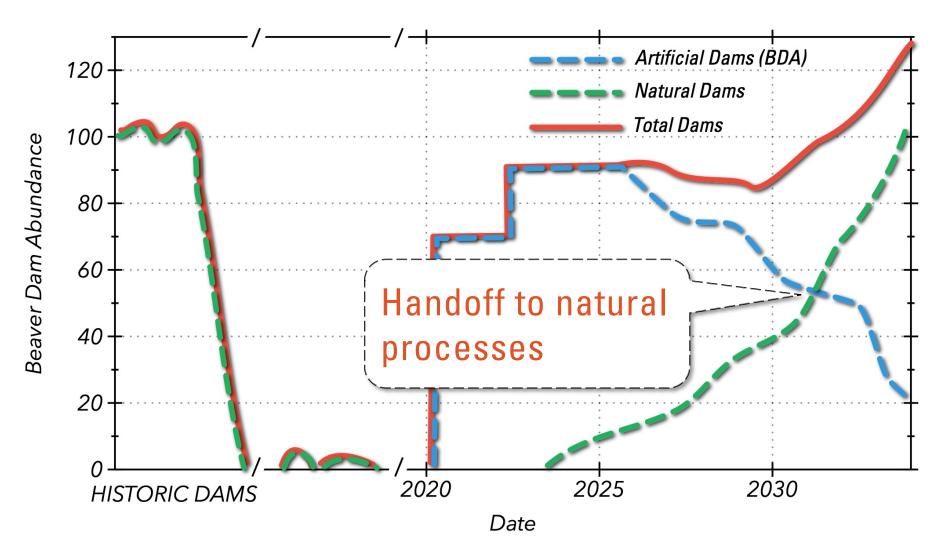




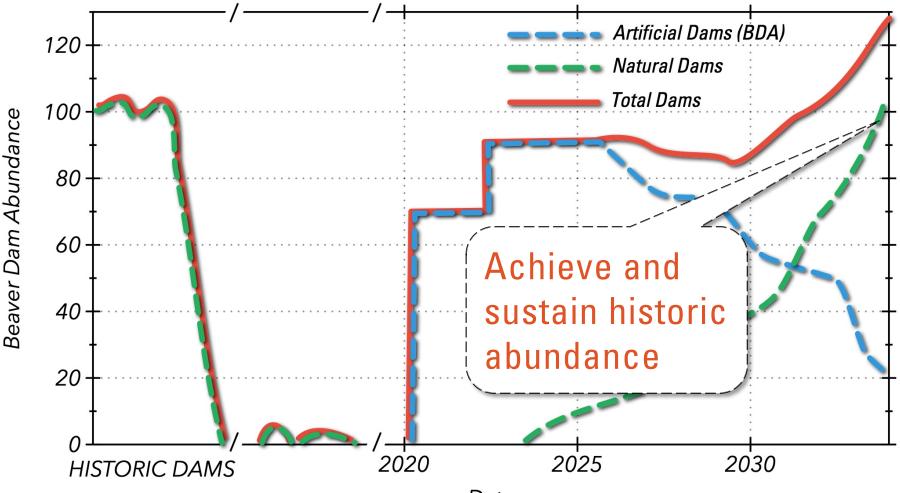
#### **Indicator Example: Dam Abundance**
