

10 Things to Remember When Pricing Your Product



10 POINTS TO WRITING THE PERFECT DESCRIPTION

- 1. Price too low customers will question the quality of your items
- 2. Customers are willing to pay more for quality
- 3. The more complex an item, the more you can charge
- 4. Don't be afraid to try listing your items at a higher price be willing to experiment
- Calculate material costs based on retail pricing and not what you paid
- 6. Set a goal charge for your time by the hour you are worth it!
- 7. Assess competitors pricing, but don't base your pricing on others
- 8. Stop thinking "What would I pay for____? It doesn't matter what price you would pay only what customers are willing to pay
- 9. Consistent pricing feel for all items
- 10. Customers don't notice price changing
