Betty was educated in the Gaston County School system and was a member of Mt. Olive Baptist Church in Kings Mountain, North Carolina.

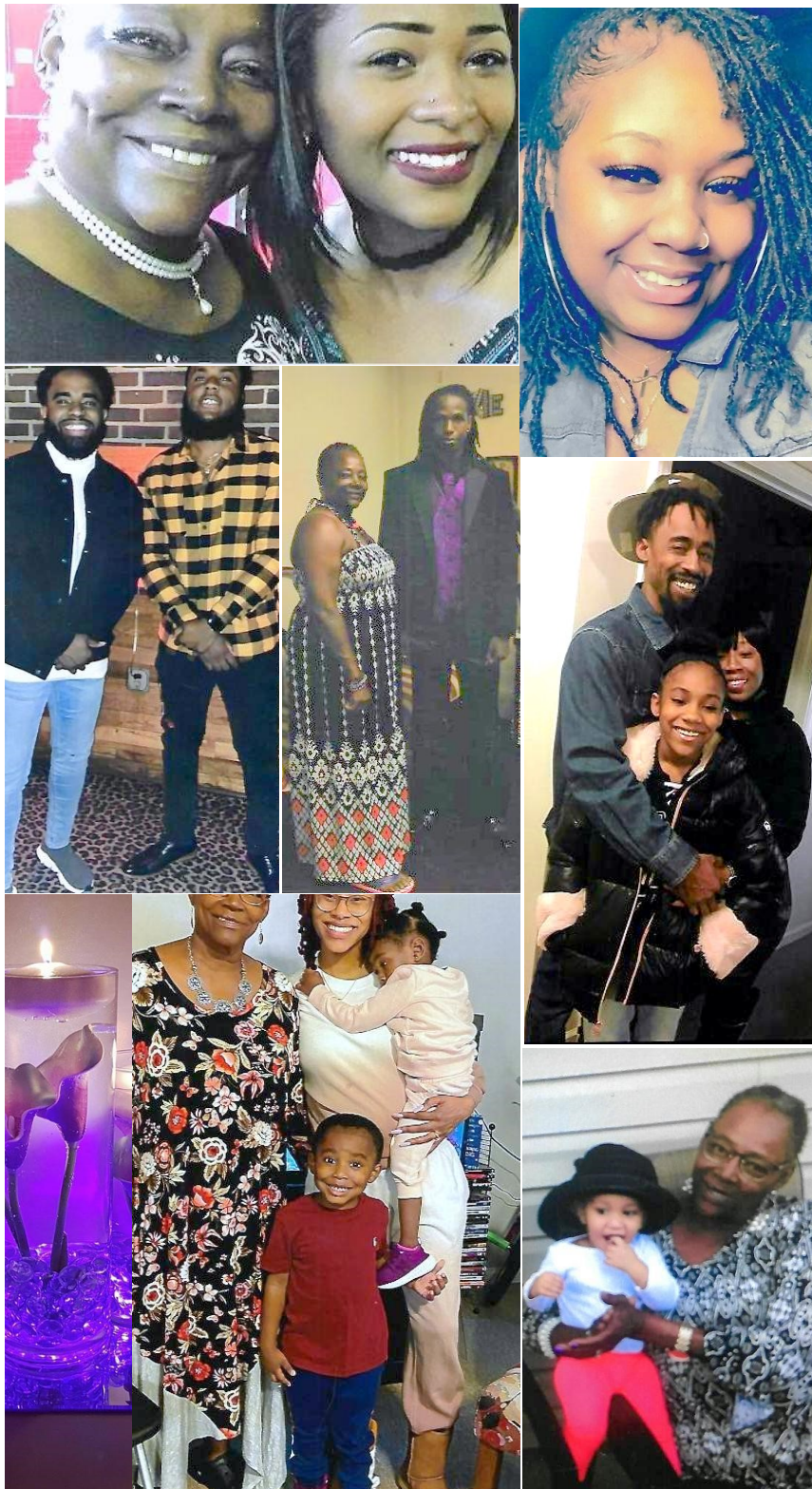
