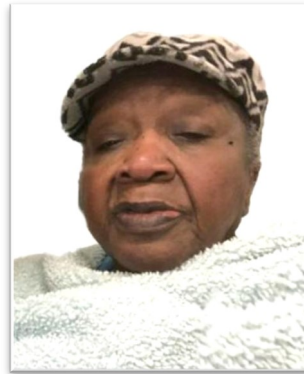

1937 – 2021



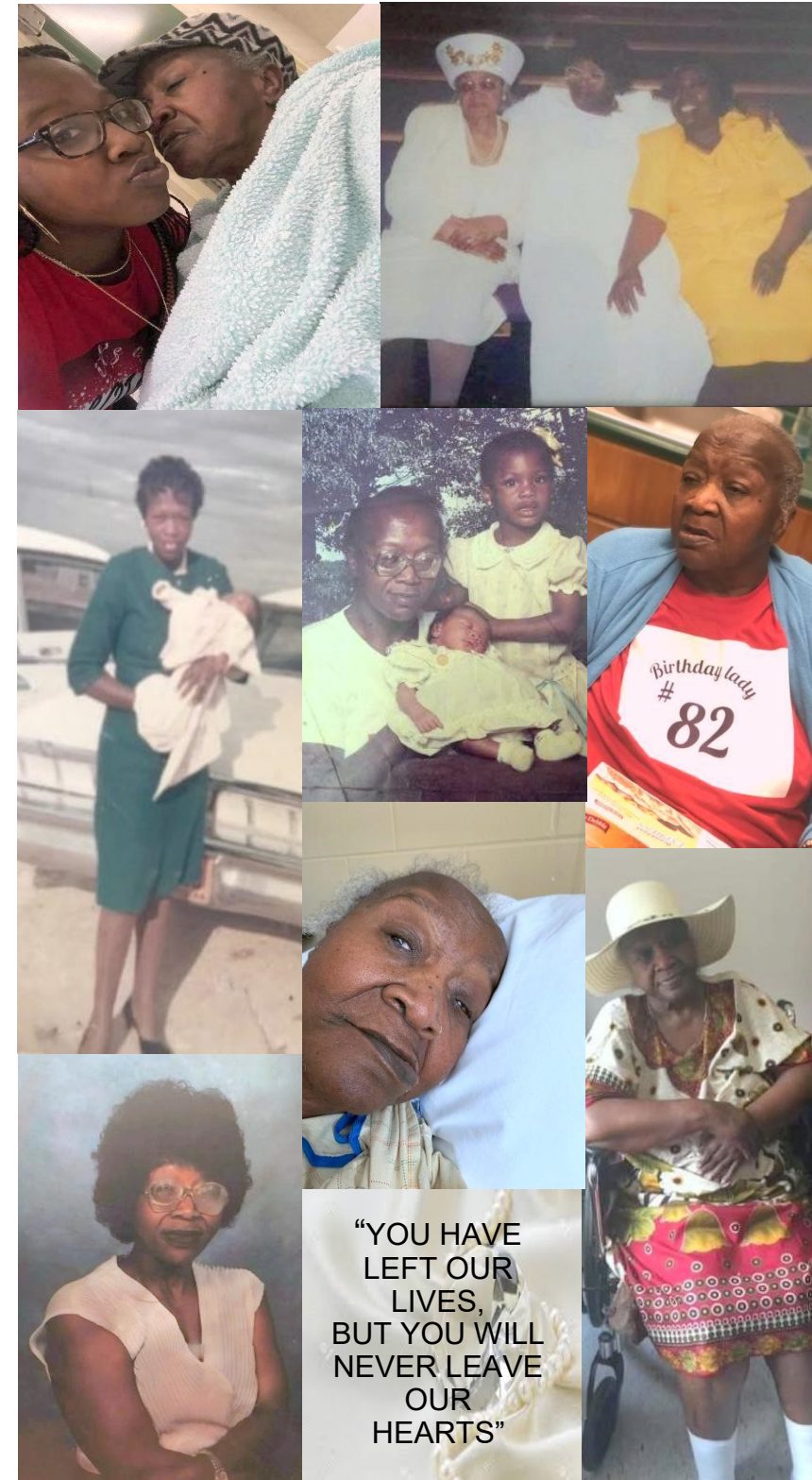
