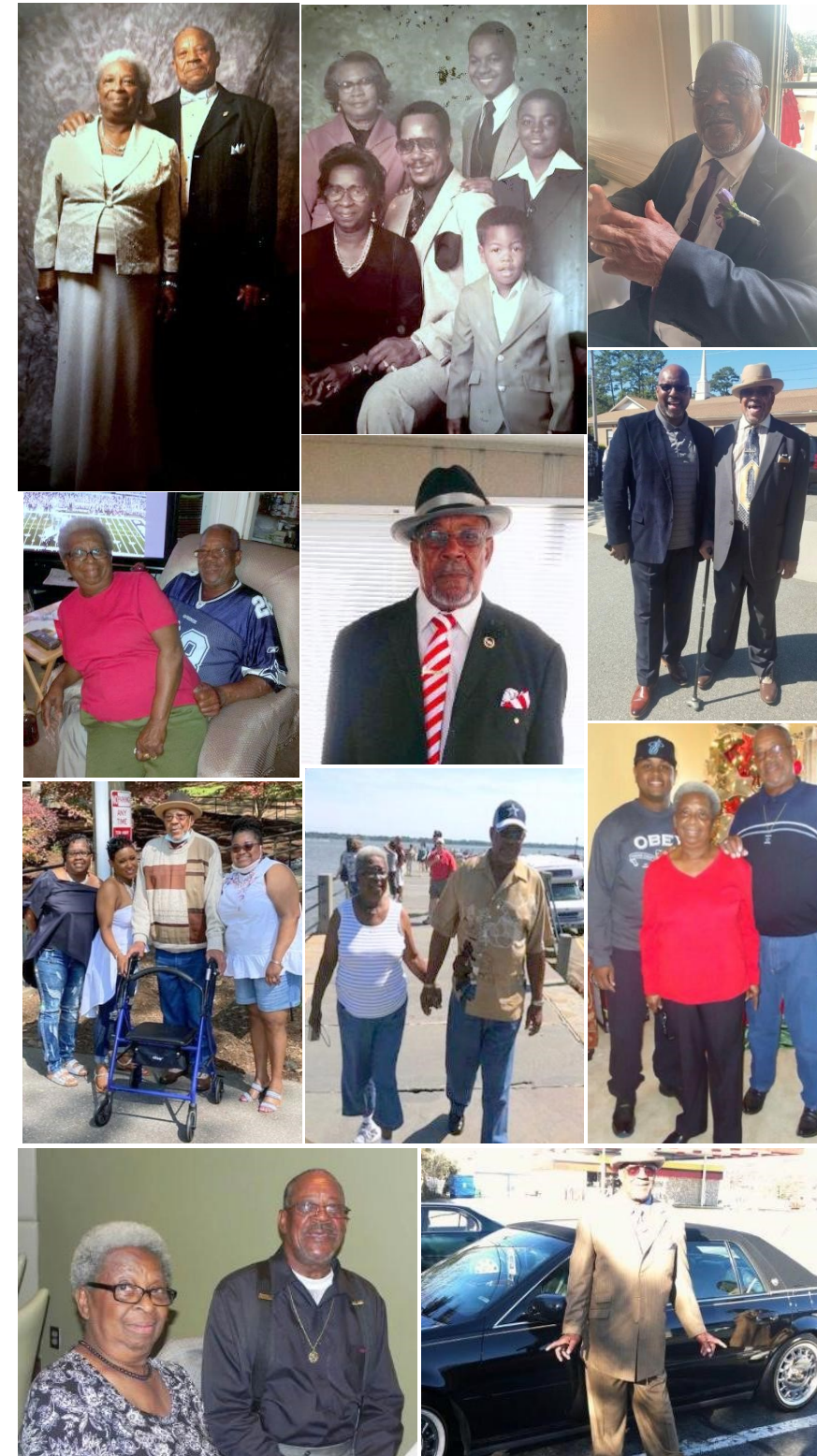
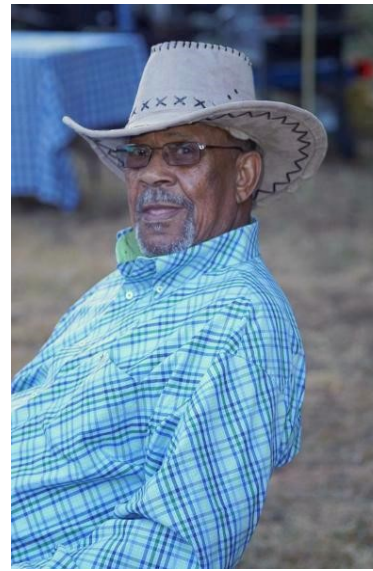
Clarence was born to the late Alexander and Juanita Gordon on January 9, 1937, in McConnells, South Carolina.

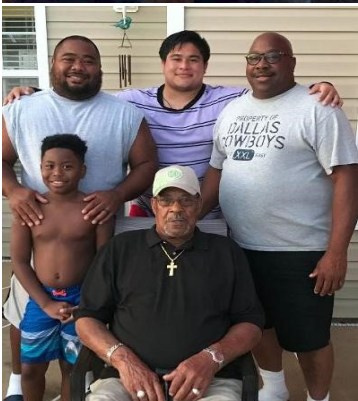

 But you will be in our hearts, now and forever.

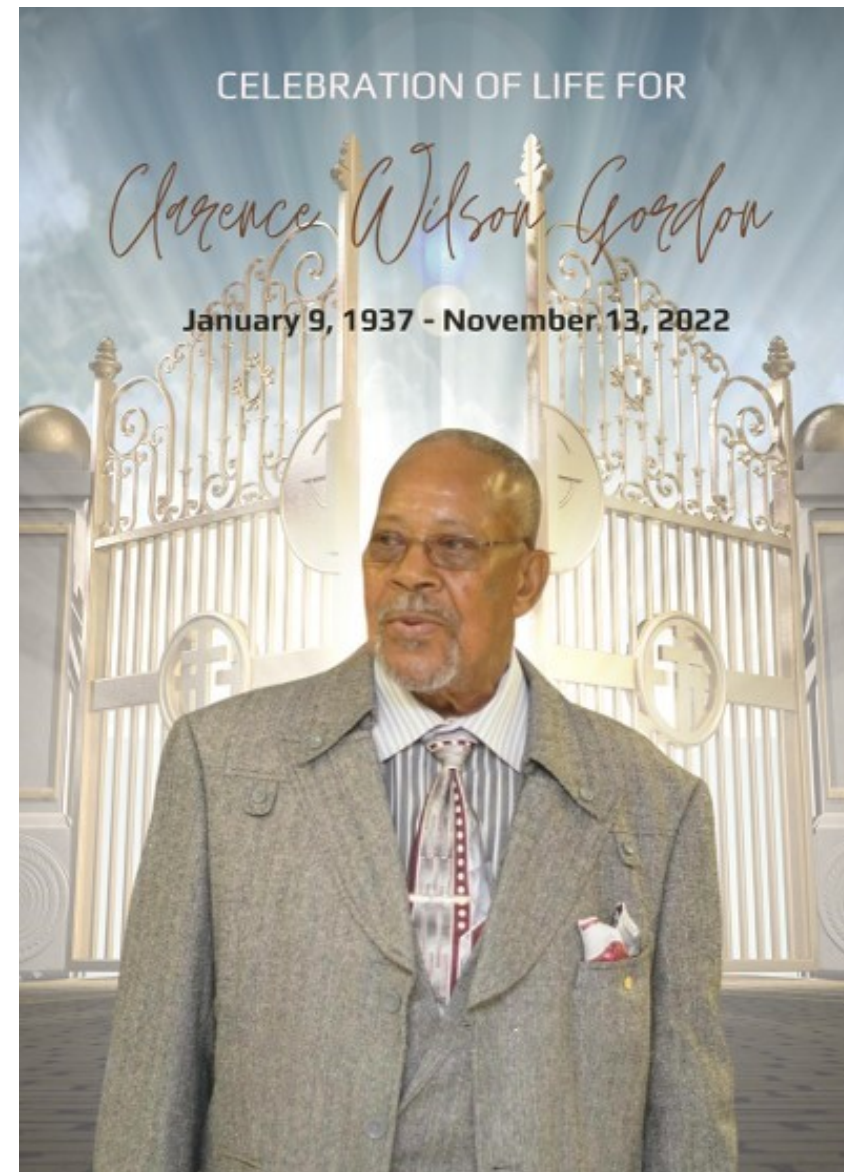
