*Mary* was an active member in church and decided at an early age to dedicate her life to Christ under the pastorate Rev. R. M. Jones.

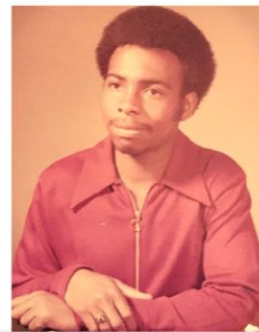
For 64 years of her life, *Mary* was a devoted wife to John Higgins.

*Mary* was a faithful member of Broadway Baptist Church in Winchester, KY where she served on the usher board and sung in the mass choir until her health prevented her from doing so.

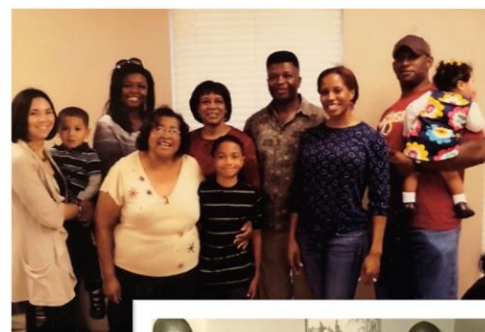
*Mary* loved singing, cooking, sewing, and spending time with family and friends.
