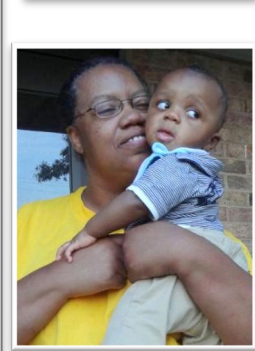
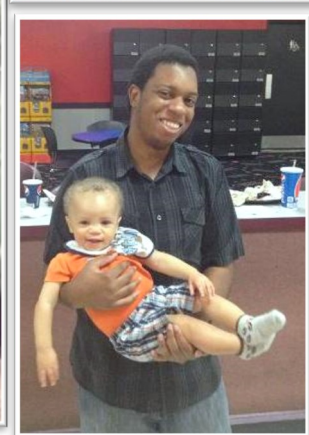
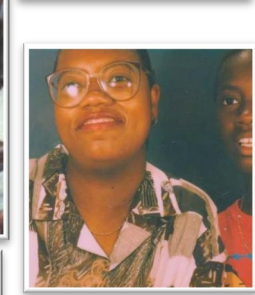
### *Greetings Family and Friends,*
