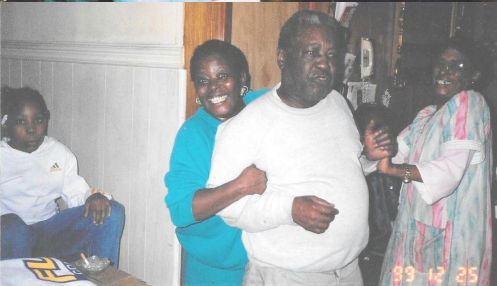
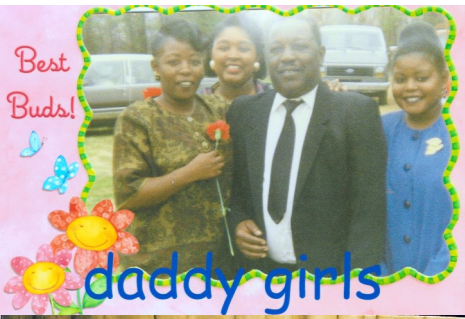
Dottie received her diploma from Hunter Huss High School in June 1977. Dottie was known for her feisty spirit and kind heart. She also liked to have family and friends around.
