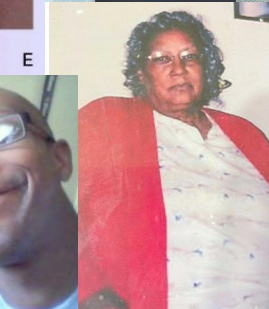
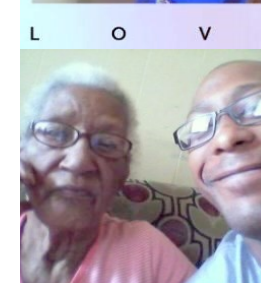
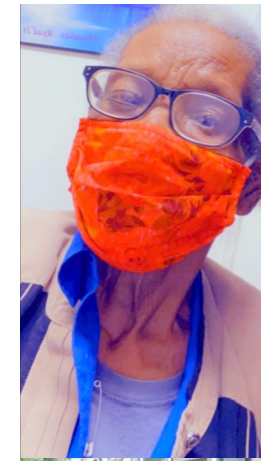
Life Reflections

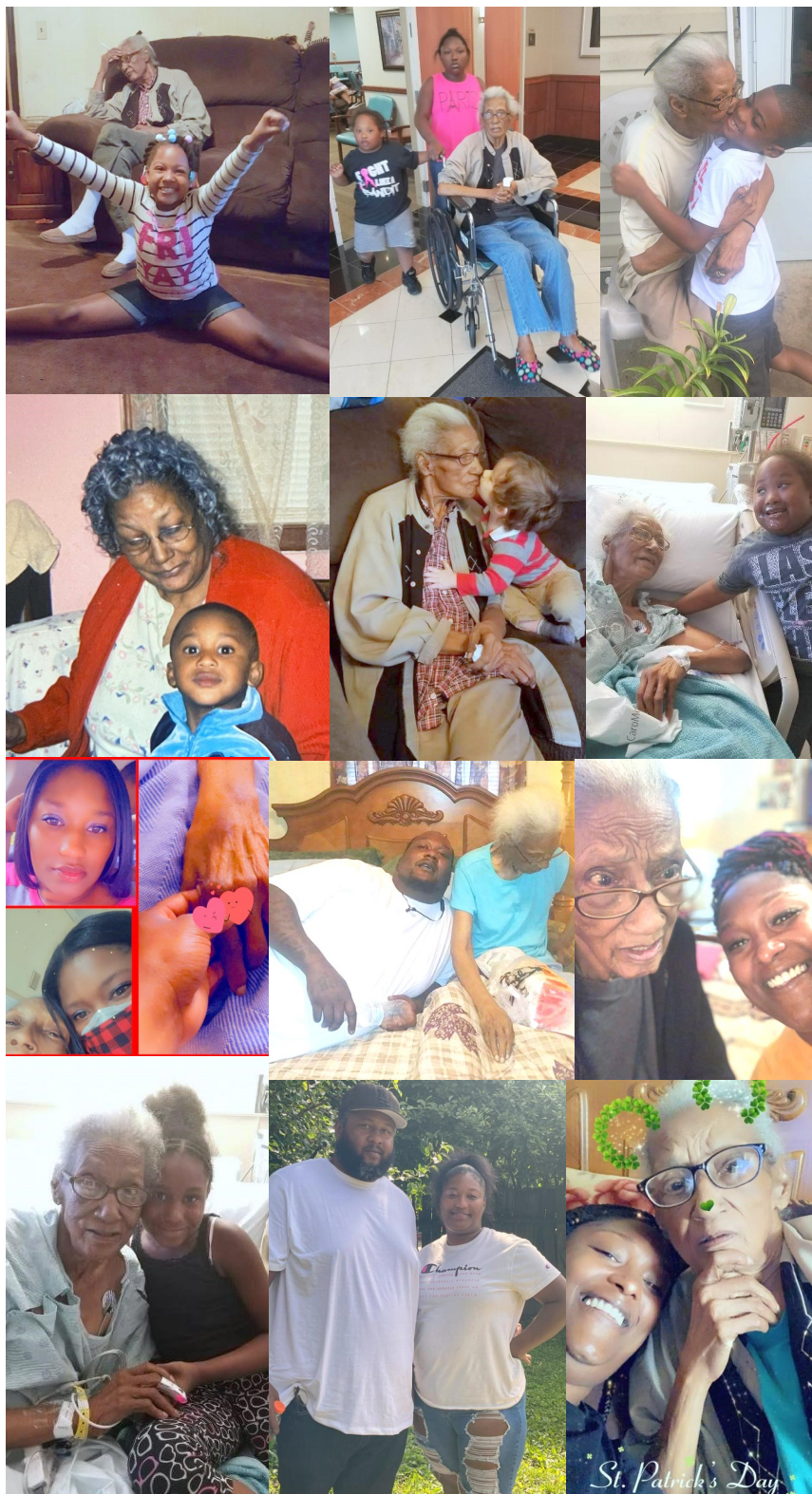
