

# Her Life Story

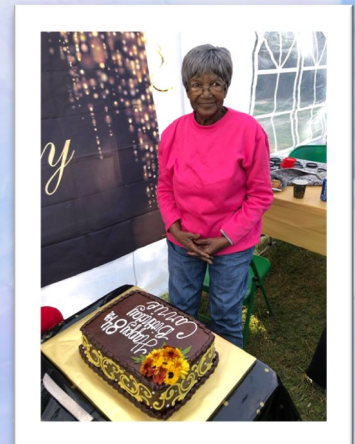
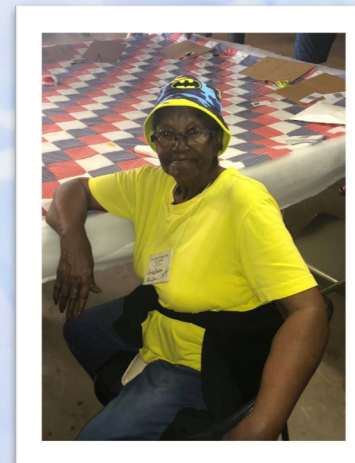
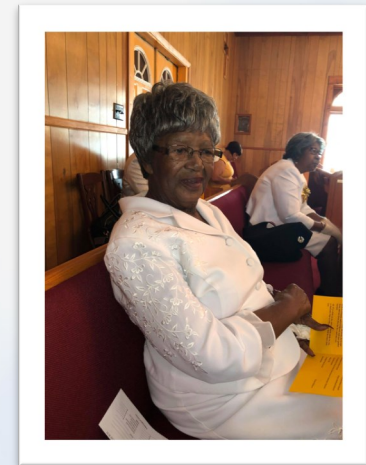
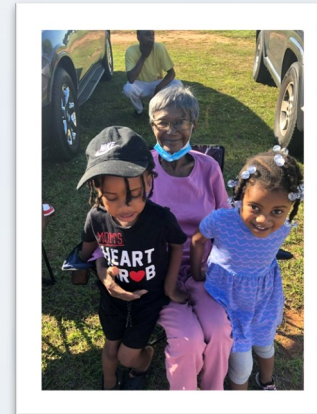
