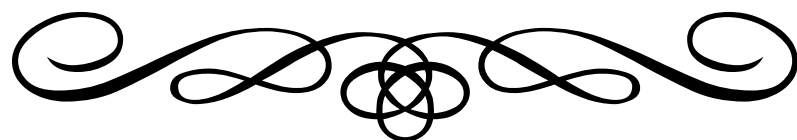


DORIS M. JORDAN WILLIAM
