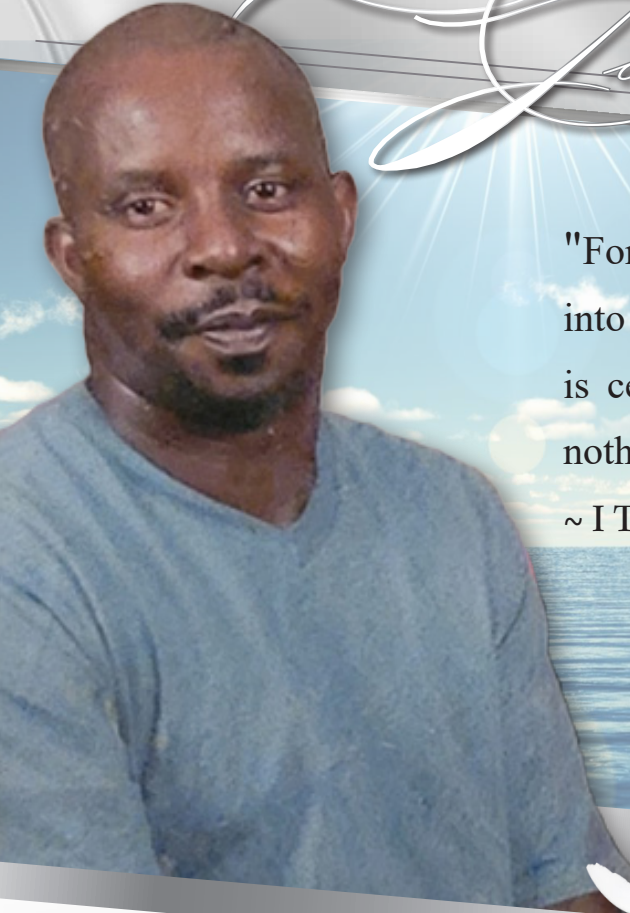

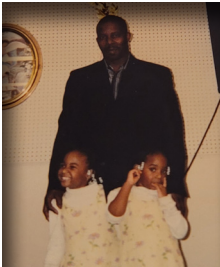
MARVIN LEON JOHNSON
