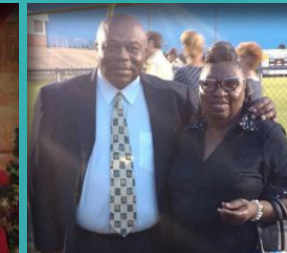
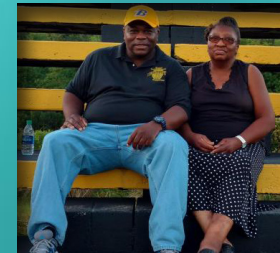
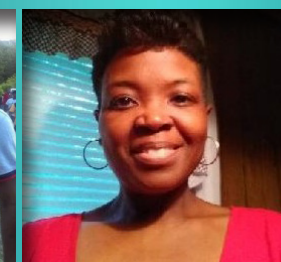
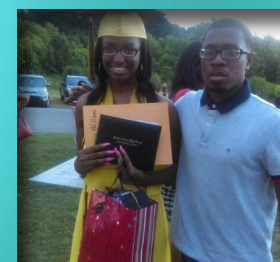
She was educated at Merritt High School in Midway, AL.
