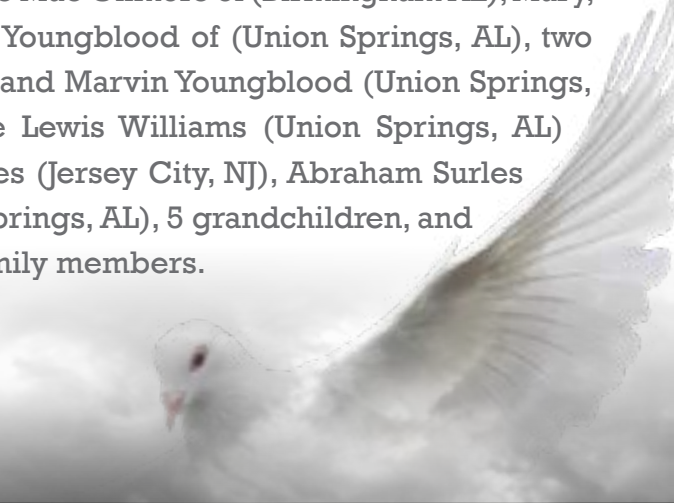


WILLIE PRESTON WILLIAMS
