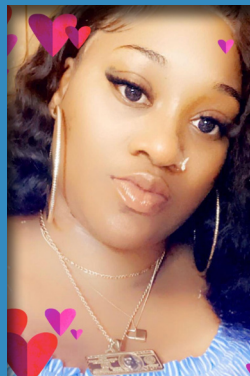


A LETTER TO TAHEERY...
