LASHAWN JOHNSON GIPSON



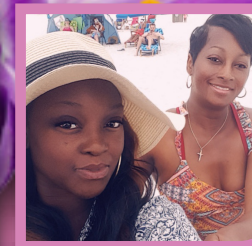
LaShawn Johnson Gipson was born July 19, 1976 in Tuskegee, Alabama to Christine Johnson and Johnny Sanders.
