You never said "I'm leaving"

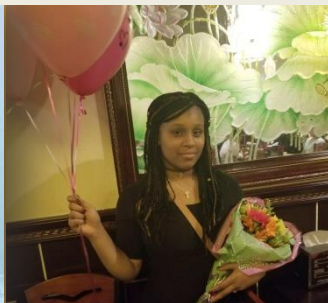
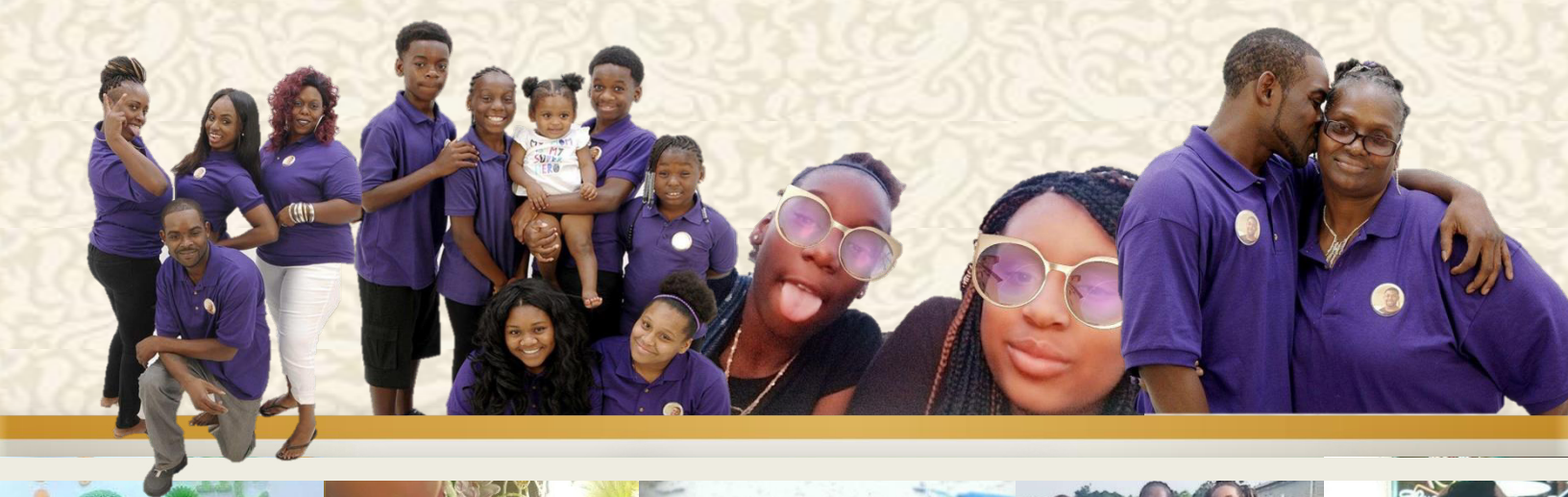

The day God took you home





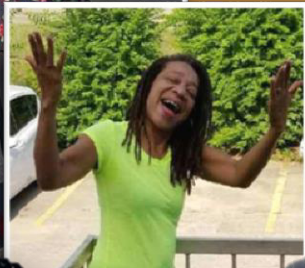
