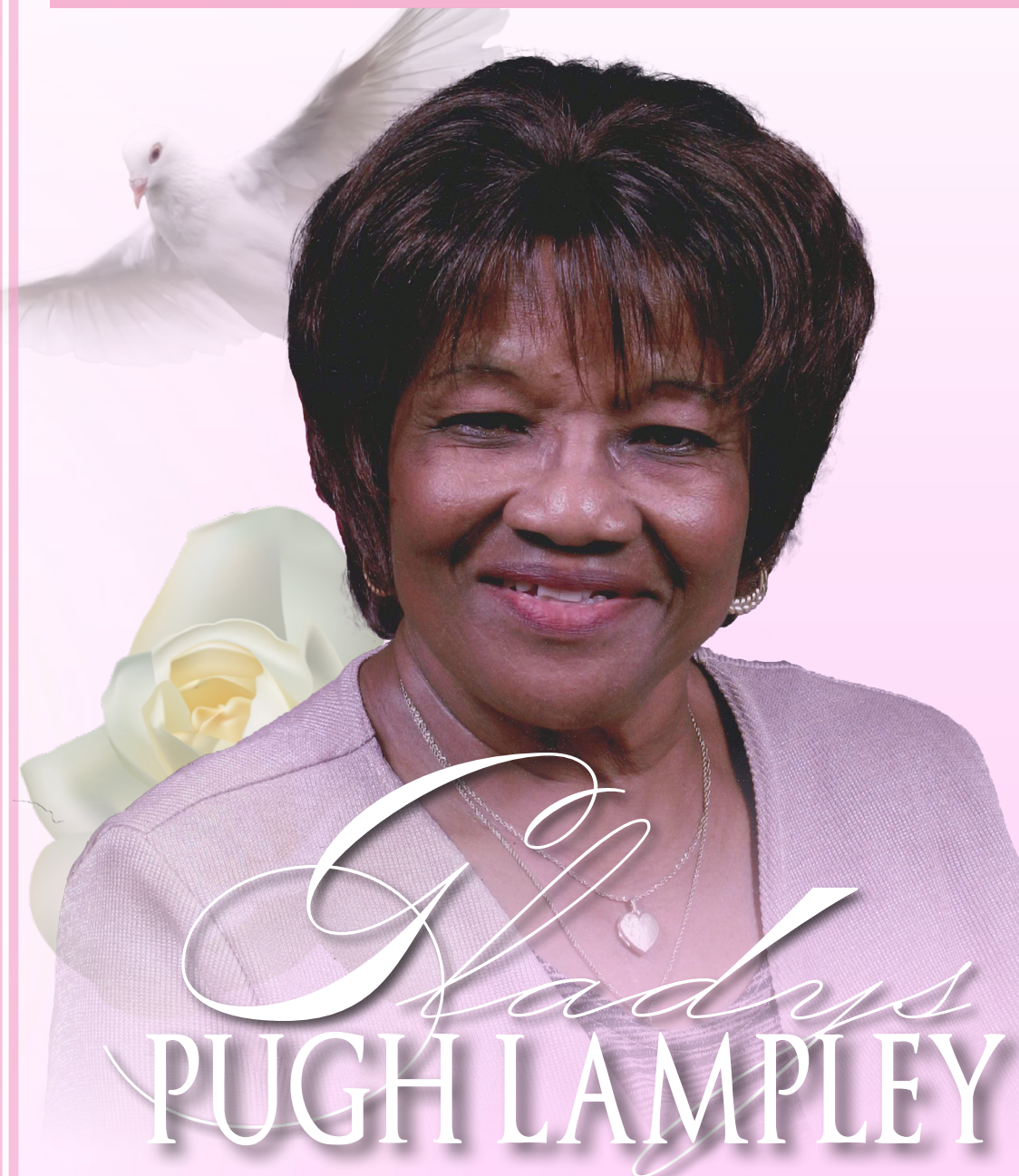

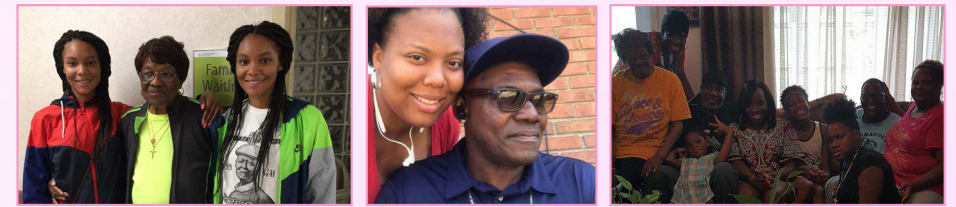
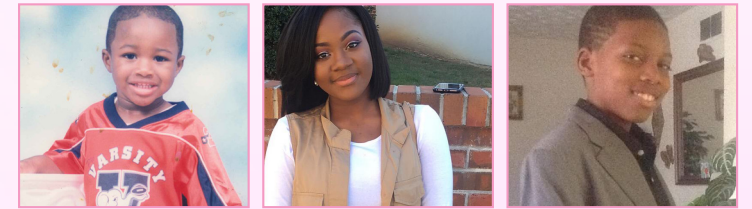
Obituary
