

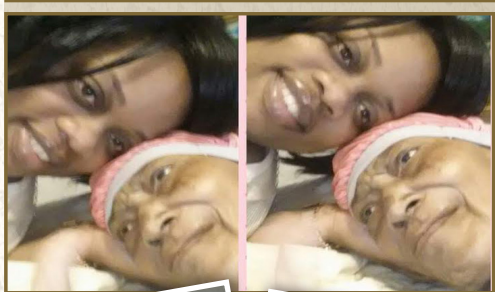
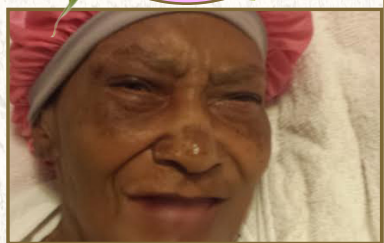


Memories
