Reflection of Life

Mr. Leroy "Nag" Calhoun, was born in Martin, South Carolina on June 12, 1958 to the late Robert Lee Calhoun and the late Rebecca Roberts Calhoun.

At an early age he joined Beulah Baptist Church in Martin, South Carolina and was later baptized. He was educated in the public schools of Allendale County and was a graduate of Allendale-Fairfax High School class of 1977. After high school, he attended the University of South Carolina-Columbia, where he studied and pursued a major in Health Education and later graduated with a Master's degree. He joined the United States Air Force and obtained the rank of Captain. His assignments included Nebraska, New York and Germany. After the military, Leroy worked as a professor at South Carolina State College, Orangeburg, South Carolina where he taught Health. He later moved to Norfolk, Virginia to pursue a teaching career. His favorite hobbies were listening to the news and watching western movies.
