Life goes on when I leave for home.

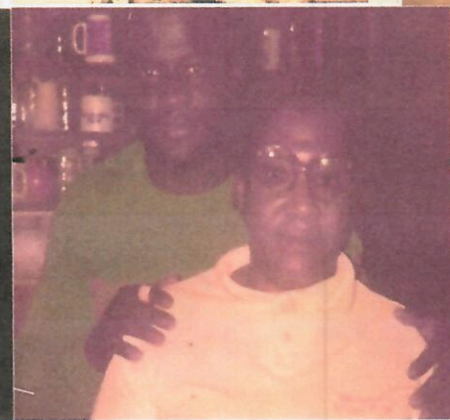
