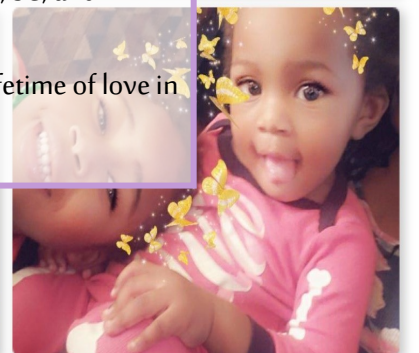
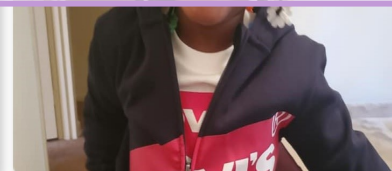
### Celebration of Maddison Olivia Jeter
