Released from his mortal life

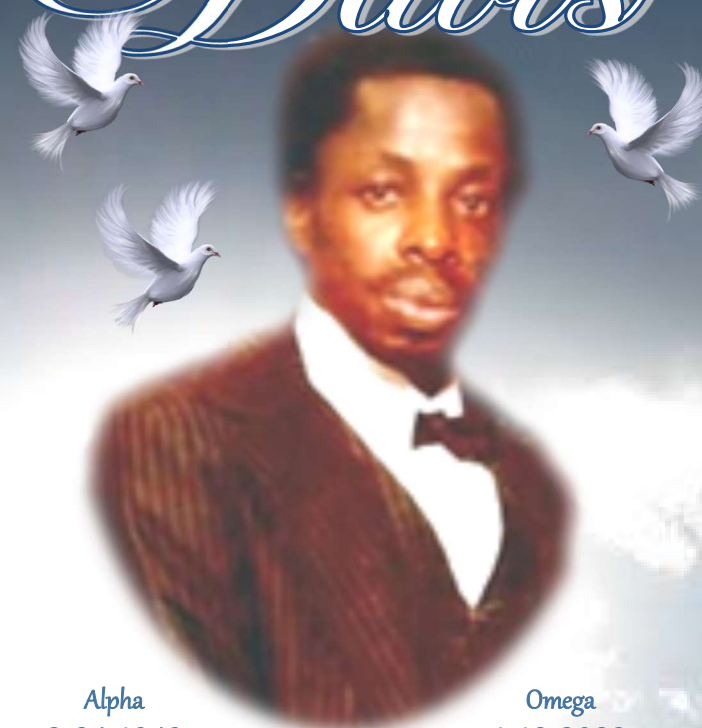
And what a reunion it must have been!
