Soft spoken at times but always heard

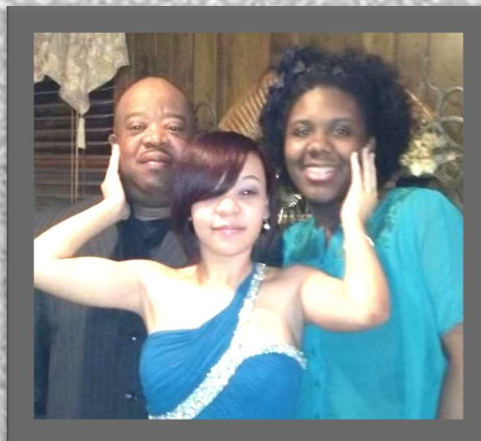
I remember my Father, capable and strong

That I've done my best to be all I can be!

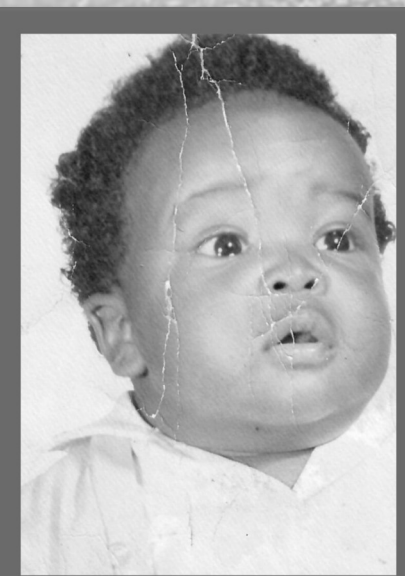


IN MEMORY OF A SPECIAL SON

The love will still remain



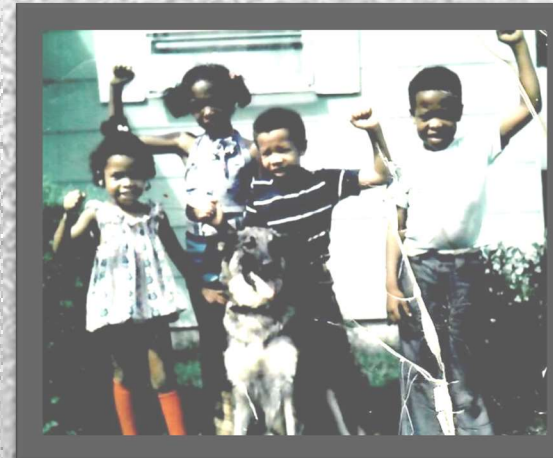
