the one from the other.

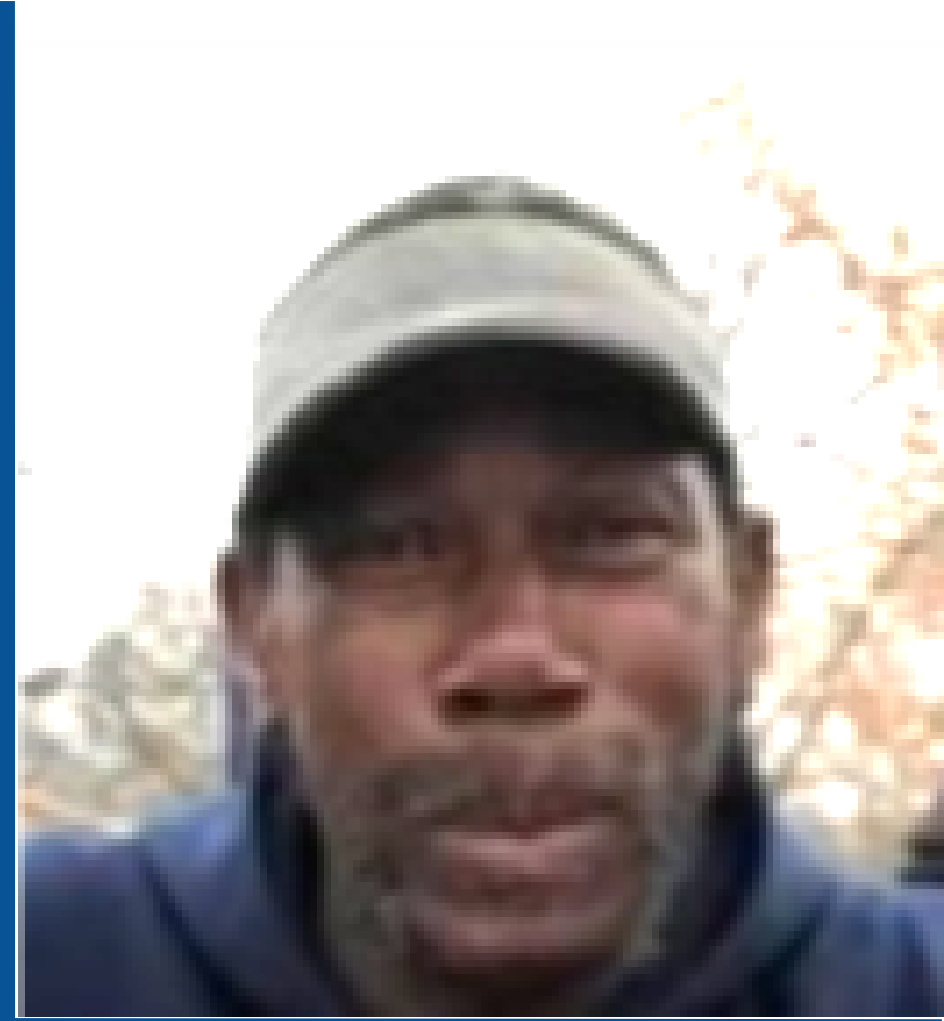
Living one day at a time,
