I am safe beneath Your wings.

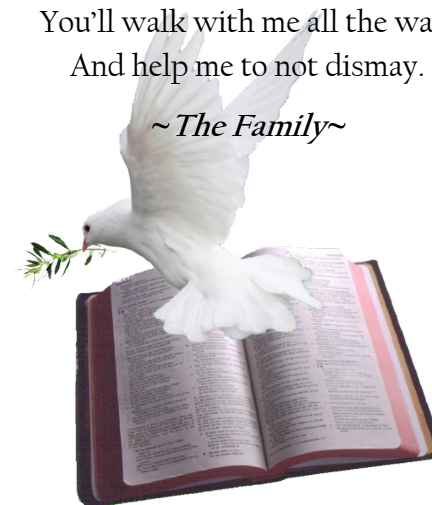
In my distress I cried, dear Lord,
