the man we called Daddy.

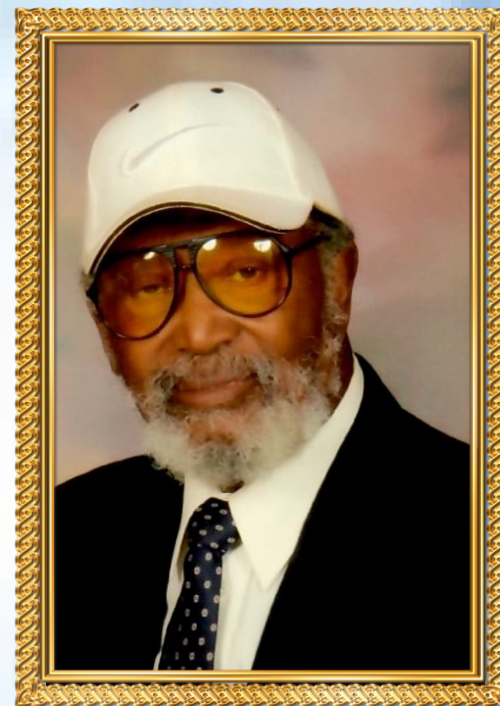

an angel here on loan.

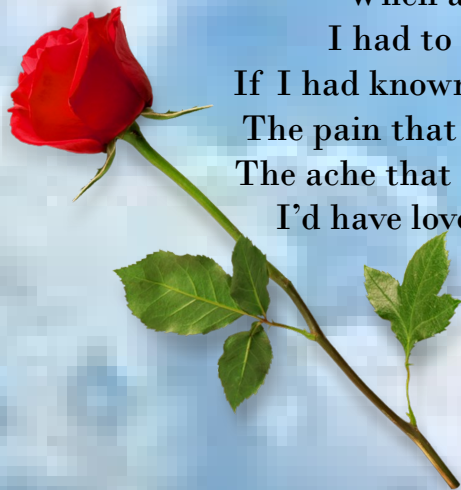
If I had known that I would miss you
