touch.

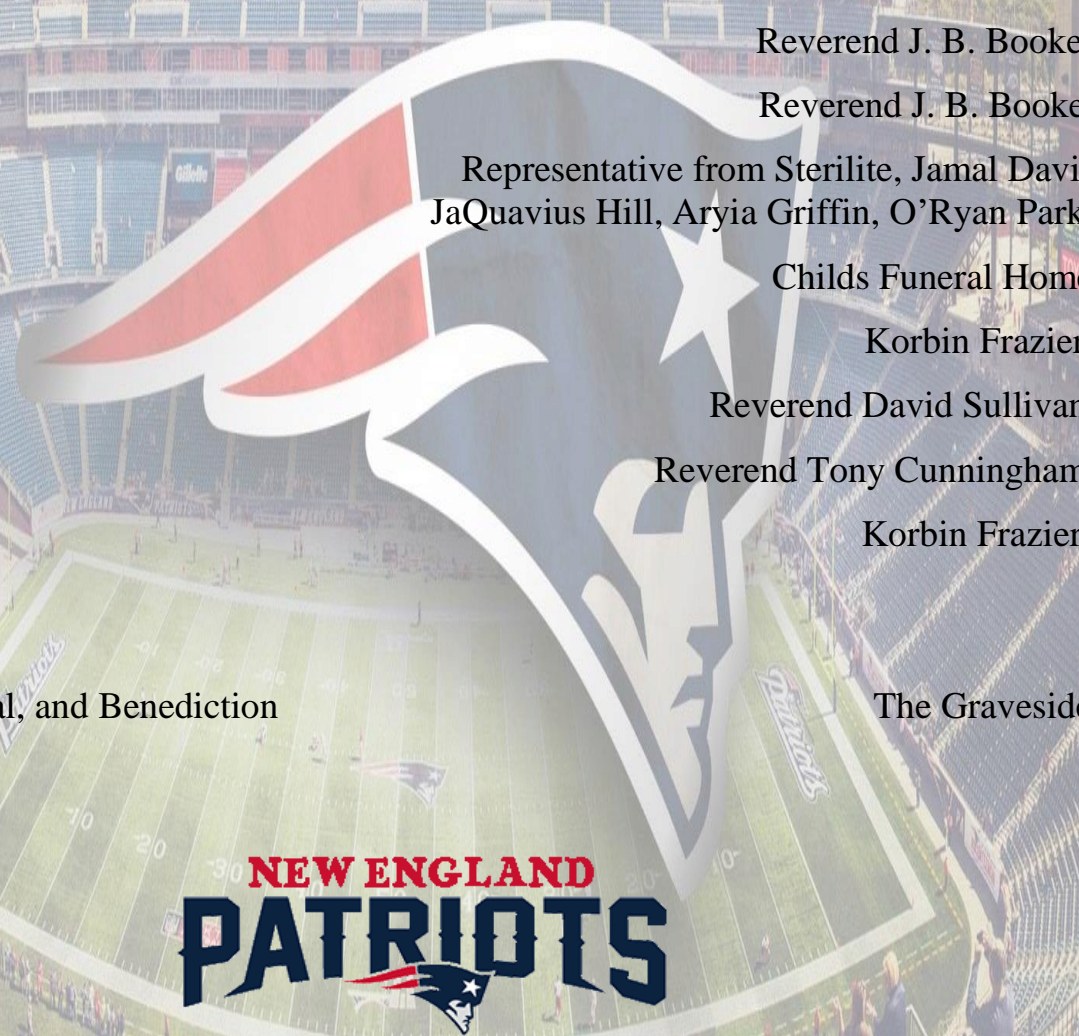
Perhaps my time seemed all too brief,

He set me free.



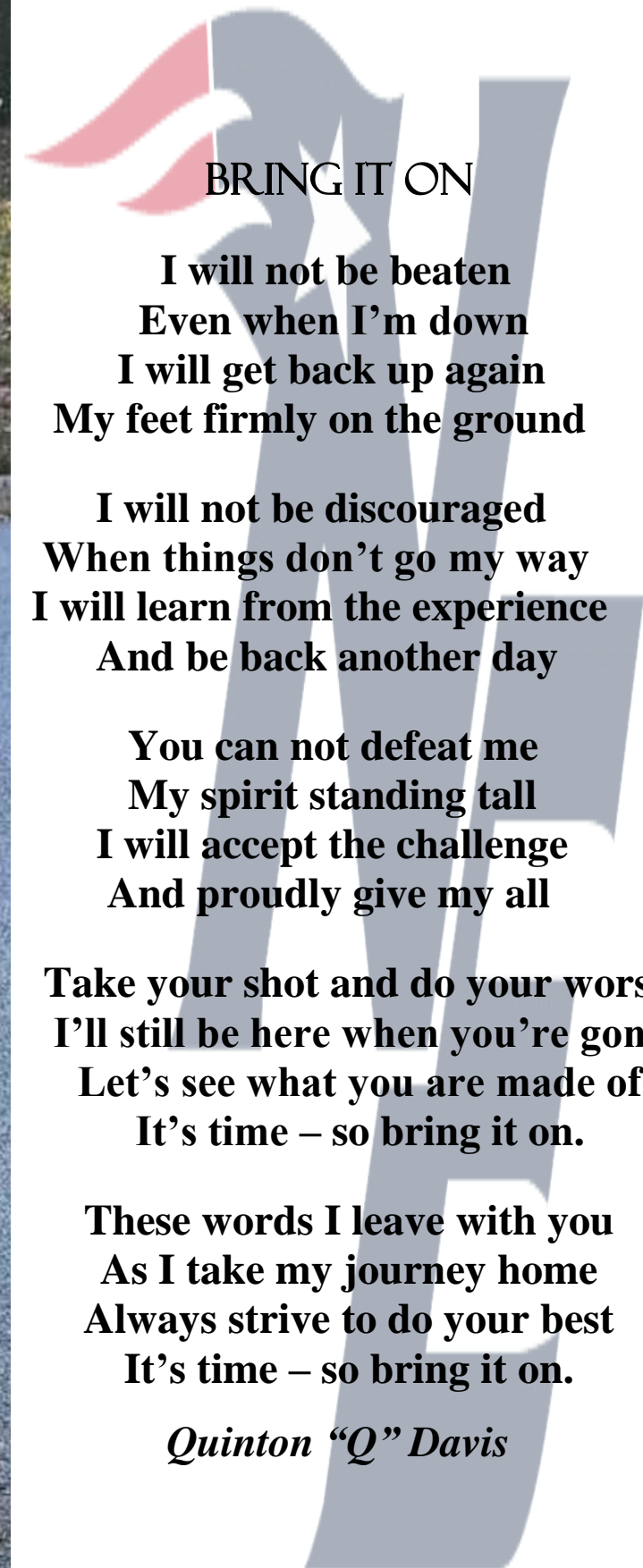

My feet firmly on the ground**

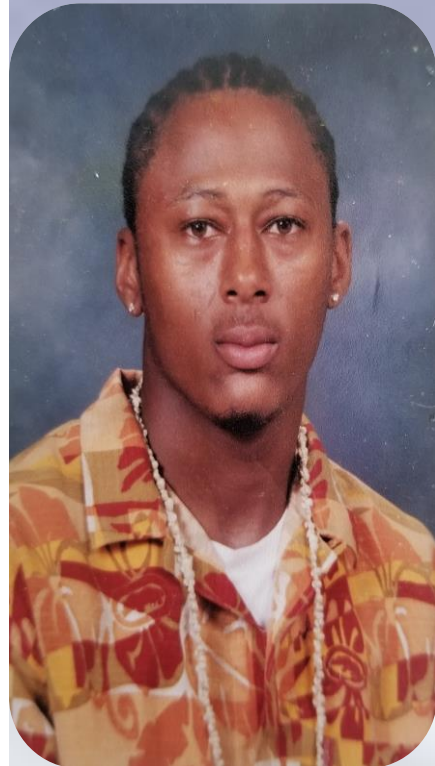
**I will not be discouraged

It's time – so bring it on.**

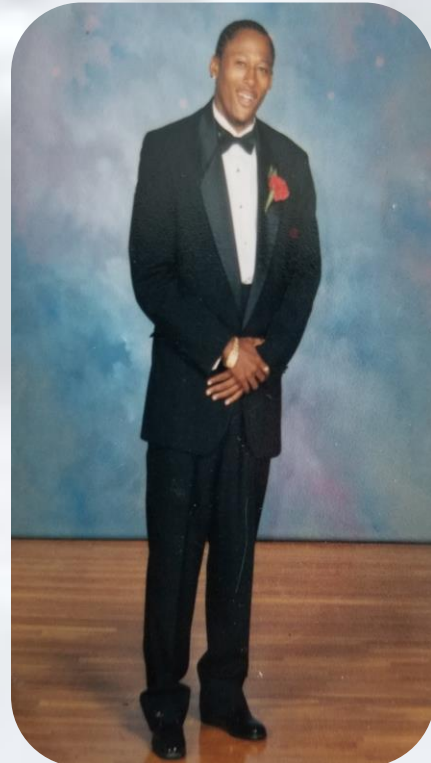
