She preached for 47 years. In her church, United Church of God in Christ for 47 years she spread the word of God so everyone she met with a smile and she welcomed all.

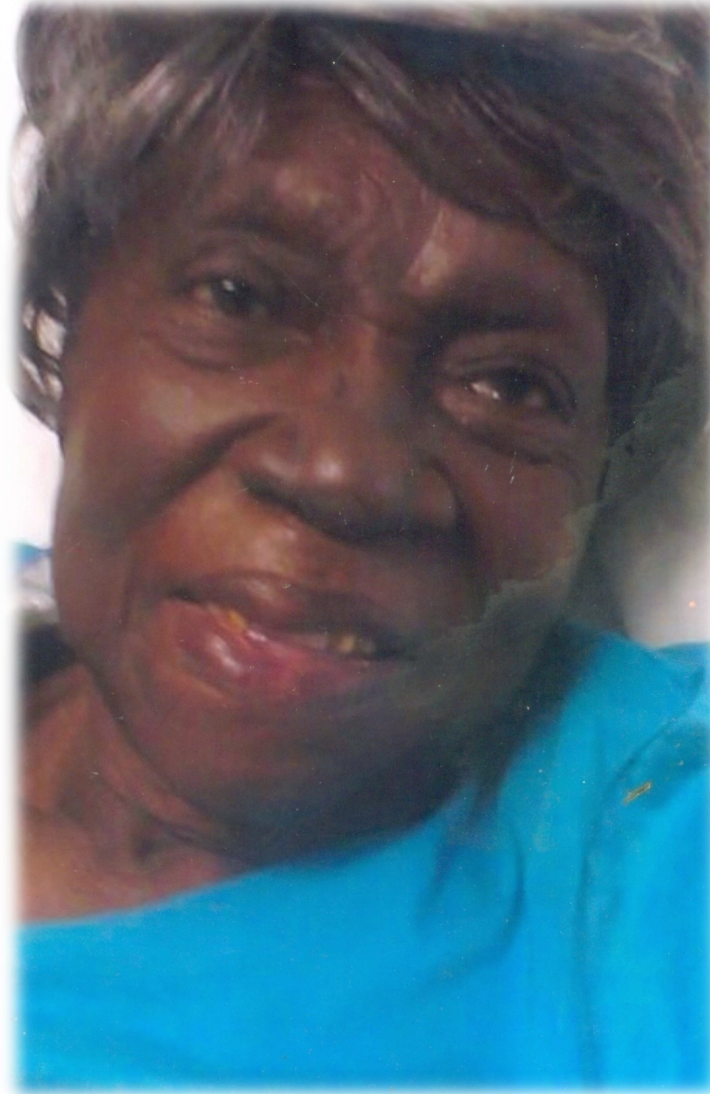
A Time To Die...
