And freed him from the pain.*

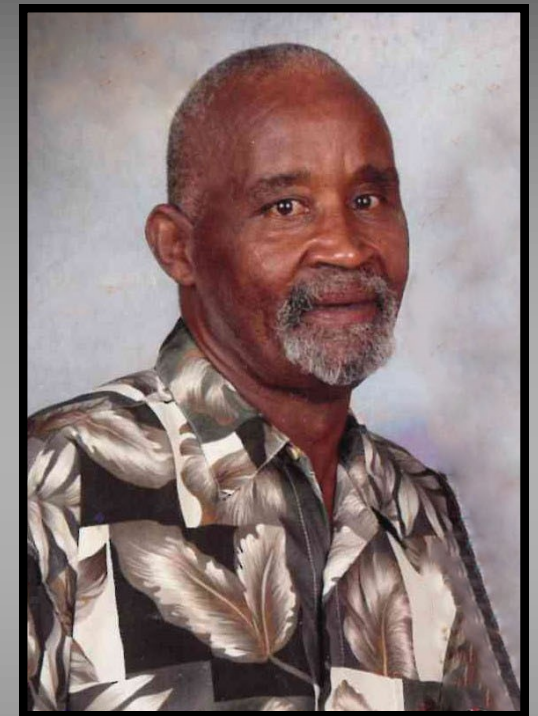

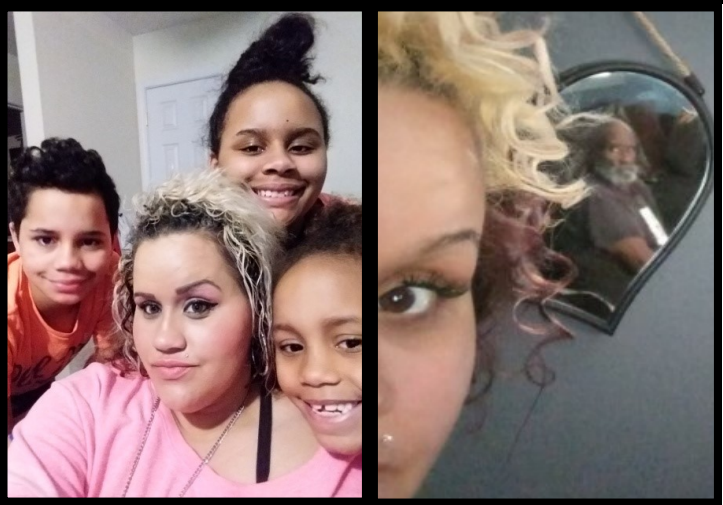
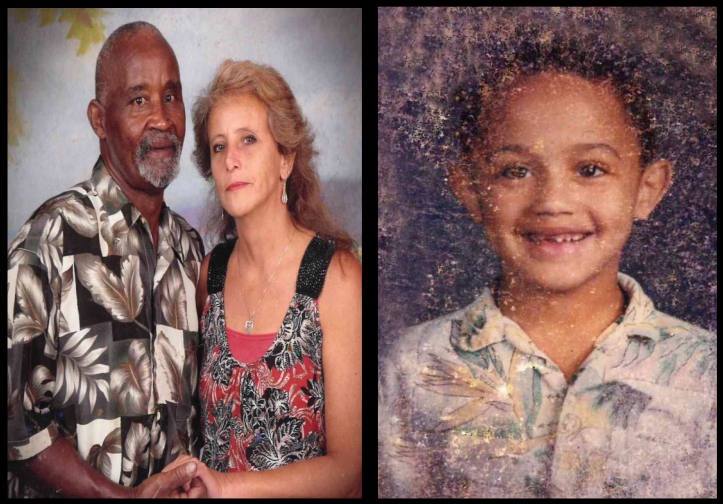
