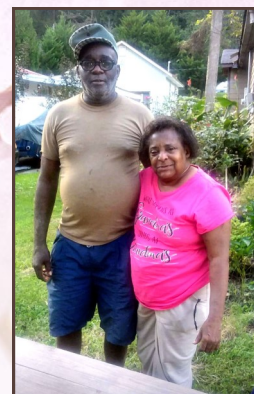
REMEMBRANCES OF
