

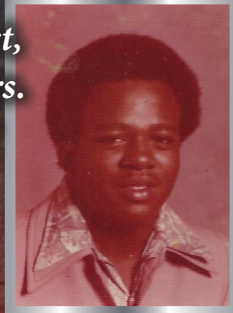
I Thessalonians 4:14-18
