DR. JAMES CHARLES COX WAS BORN JANUARY 3, 1975, TO THE LATE PATRICIA ANN (NICHOLSON) COX AND THE LATE JAMES CORNELIUS ROBBINS. HE WAS THE 11TH SIBLING OF 15 CHILDREN. JAMES CHARLES TRANSITIONED FROM EARTH TO BE WITH HIS HEAVENLY FATHER ON JANUARY 5, 2023. HE WAS 48 YEARS OLD.

AS A CHILD, JAMES WAS ALWAYS THOUGHTFUL, WELL MANNERED, AND HAD A QUIET SPIRIT; YET HE WAS CONSTANTLY OBSERVANT AND VERY VOCAL REGARDING THINGS HE WAS PASSIONATE ABOUT. JAMES WAS INTELLECTUALLY INQUISITIVE AND A VORACIOUS READER WHO WAS INTERESTED IN A VAST ARRAY OF TOPICS. HE HAD A BURNING DESIRE TO LEARN AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE TO EXPAND HIS KNOWLEDGE. EDUCATION WAS TRULY HIS FOCUS. AS A TEEN, JAMES EXHIBITED AN ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT BY SELLING CANDY, SNACKS, AND OTHER ITEMS TO EARN MONEY FOR WHATEVER HE DESIRED. JAMES WAS RELENTLESSLY DETERMINED TO ACCOMPLISH HIS GOALS AND OVERCOME ANY OBSTACLES HE ENCOUNTERED IN LIFE. HE ATTENDED VICKSBURG AND JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC SCHOOLS. HE GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL WITH HONORS AND CONTINUED HIS EDUCATION TO OBTAIN HIS BACHELOR'S, MASTER'S, AND DOCTORATE DEGREES WHILE RECEIVING VARIOUS ACCOLADES IN THE PROCESS.

JAMES WAS EMPLOYED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO WHERE HE WAS A WELL-RESPECTED DIRECTOR OF THE JOE CROWLEY STUDENT UNION. JAMES WAS APPOINTED THIS POSITION FOLLOWING A NATIONWIDE HIRING SEARCH. HE SUPERVISED A LARGE TEAM OF FULL-TIME STAFF AND STUDENT EMPLOYEES. HE TOOK HIS JOB EXTREMELY SERIOUSLY AND WORKED HARD TO MAKE CERTAIN THAT EVERY TASK WAS COMPLETED WITH EXCELLENCE.

AS A PART OF JAMES' PASSION FOR EDUCATION, HE WAS DRIVEN TO HELP OTHERS AND ENCOURAGED STUDENTS TO REFRAME ADVERSE CHALLENGES TO BE SIMPLY MOTIVATORS TO THEIR EDUCATIONAL GOALS. JAMES' SUPERVISORS AND COLLEAGUES STATED, "JAMES DEMONSTRATED A WILLINGNESS TO ALWAYS LISTEN, TO MENTOR, AND SELFLESSLY GUIDE COUNTLESS STUDENTS AS WELL AS STAFF." JAMES WAS A MEMBER OF THE FIRST-GENERATION COALITION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO WHICH WAS AN ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO CREATING POSITIVE EXPERIENCES AND EMPOWERING FIRST-GENERATION STUDENT SUCCESS. STUDENTS, HE ALWAYS SAID, WERE HIS TOP PRIORITY AND HE MADE THIS HIS PROFESSIONAL MISSION AND HIS PERSONAL CALLING.

JAMES REALIZED HE HAD A SPECIAL TALENT IN WORKING WITH AND RELATING TO PEOPLE, AND HIS ABILITY PERMEATED EVERY ASPECT OF HIS WORK. HE OFTEN WORKED INTO THE EVENING, WELL PAST NINE OR TEN O'CLOCK – AS THESE WERE OFTEN THE BEST TIMES TO BE WITH STUDENTS, TO LEARN IN AN INFORMAL YET CARING WAY ABOUT THEIR VARIOUS PERSONAL STORIES, THEIR GOALS AND ASPIRATIONS, AND HOW HE AND HIS STAFF COULD HELP THEM.

JAMES OFFERED HIS OWN MISSISSIPPI-STYLE FOOD THAT HE PREPARED AT HOME FOR STUDENTS WHO MIGHT NOT BE ABLE TO AFFORD OR EVEN HAVE A MEAL. HE TRULY WALKED THE WALK AS AN ADVOCATE. HE SAW BEAUTY AND POTENTIAL IN EVERY STUDENT, BECOMING PERSONALLY VESTED IN EVERYONE HE COULD HELP TO PURSUE THEIR DREAMS. JAMES' PREVIOUS PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE INCLUDED ADMINISTRATIVE POSITIONS AT JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY, VIRGINIA TECH UNIVERSITY, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MEMPHIS.

JAMES' MAIN PERSON IN HIS LIFE WAS HIS MOTHER, "PAT COX." HE HAD A GREAT LOVE AND RESPECT FOR HER. AS AN ADULT, HE ALWAYS DESIRED AND TRIED TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL HER NEEDS WERE MEET, EVEN IF IT REQUIRED HIM TO GIVE HER HIS LAST DIME. PAT WAS ALWAYS VERY WELL PLEASED WITH HIS ACCOLADES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS, BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, SHE CHERISHED THE PERSON HE WAS AND APPRECIATED HOW WELL HE TREATED HER AND DEMONSTRATED HIS LOVE FOR HER.

JAMES ALSO HAD A UNIQUE LOVE FOR HIS FAMILY WITH EVERYONE HAVING A SPECIAL PLACE. HE WAS ADMIRED FOR HOW SMART HE WAS; AND SO MANY PEOPLE SOUGHT HIS ADVICE AND BENEFITED FROM HIS INSIGHTS AND EXPLANATIONS REGARDING A VARIETY OF COMPLICATED TOPICS. HE HAD GREAT PERSPECTIVE, INTUITION, KNOWLEDGE, AND WISDOM. JAMES WAS ALSO QUICK-WITTED AND HAD A SHARP SENSE OF HUMOR. "STRONG MINDED" WOULD BE AN UNDERSTATEMENT FOR HIS CHARACTER. HE SPOKE HIS TRUTH WITH CONVICTION WITHOUT BACKING DOWN AND WAS STRAIGHT TO THE POINT WITH EVERYONE - NO SUGAR COATING. HE SEEMED TO NEVER BE CONCERNED ABOUT OTHERS' OPINIONS OF HIM. HE WOULD TELL YOU RIGHT FROM WRONG AND YOU COULD DEAL WITH IT HOWEVER YOU CHOSE. YET, HE WAS ALSO AN EXTREMELY CARING, KINDHEARTED, GENEROUS INDIVIDUAL. HE WAS THE FAMILY'S CUSHION WHEN THEY FELL; THERE WHEN ANYONE FELT UNLOVED; SIMPLY OUR "BIG TEDDY BEAR." WHEN HE HUGGED, YOU FELT THE LOVE COMING FROM OUTSIDE INTO YOUR HEART. JAMES LOVED TO EAT (LIKE THE REST OF THE FAMILY) AND WAS AN EXCELLENT COOK. JAMES WAS AN AVID READER OF THE HOLY BIBLE SPENDING TIME WITH GOD BEFORE GOING TO SLEEP AT NIGHT. THE FAMILY ALWAYS COUNTED ON HIS HOME COOKED MEALS AND LOOKED FORWARD TO HIM COMING HOME AS HE WOULD CHEERFULLY COMMANDEER THE KITCHEN. AS PART OF JAMES' HOBBIES, HE ENJOYED GOING TO CASINOS AND PLAYING BINGO. HE NEVER LEARNED TO DRIVE, YET IT NEVER HINDERED HIM FROM TRAVELING EVERYWHERE HE

JAMES LIVED LIFE TO THE FULLEST AS AN INDIVIDUAL, SON, BROTHER, UNCLE, NEPHEW, COUSIN, FRIEND, AND MENTOR. WHILE OUR HEARTS ARE TORN AND ACHE FOR JAMES' PHYSICAL PRESENCE, WE LOOK FORWARD TO REJOICING WITH HIM AGAIN WHEN WE GO HOME TO FATHER GOD/LORD JESUS CHRIST. OUR FAMILY'S MOST "GENTLE GIANT" IS TREMENDOUSLY MISSED BUT WILL LIVE IN OUR HEARTS AND IS WITH US IN SPIRIT FOREVER. JAMES LEAVES A GENERATIONAL LEGACY OF LOVED ONES. (SEE PAGES 5 & 6).
