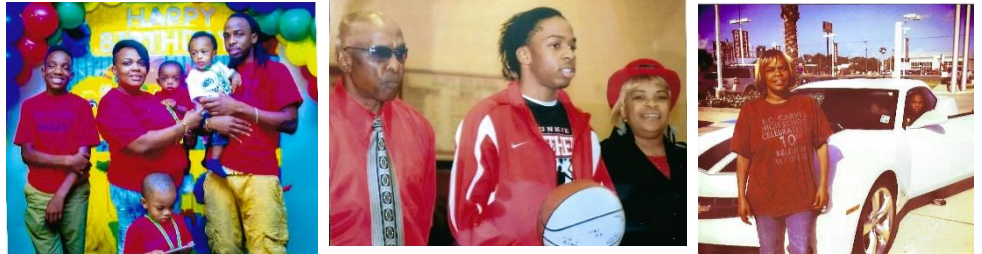
## *To Our Mother*
