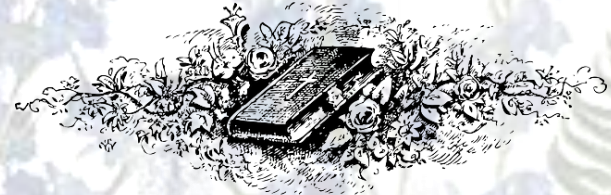
Wayne was considered quite a "character" making friends wherever he went!
