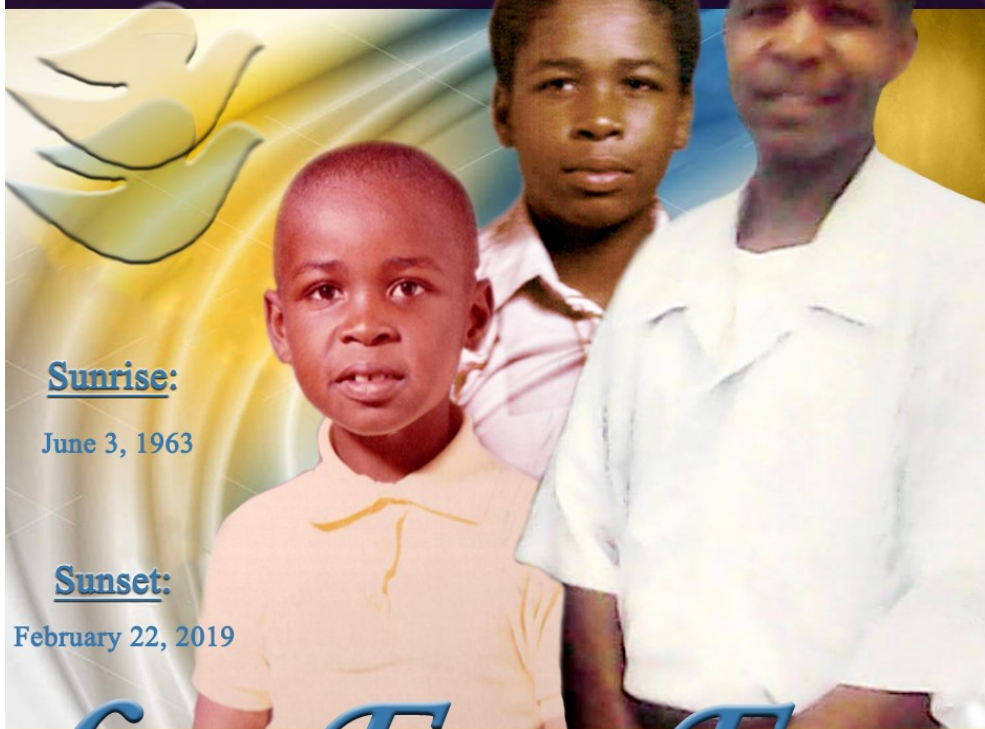

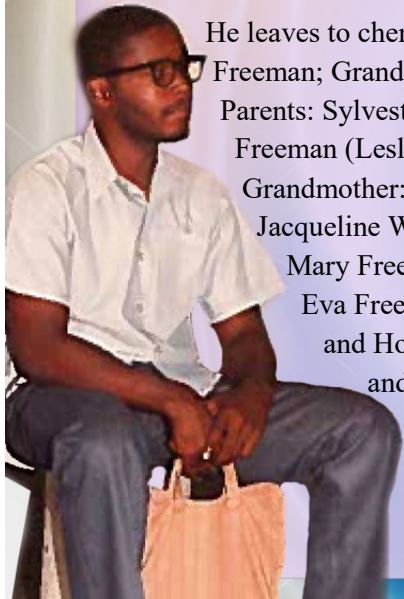
Obituary

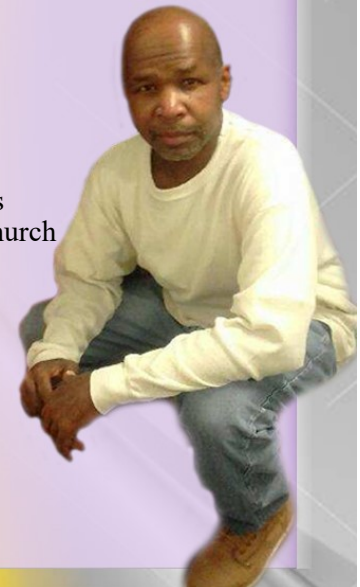
