Obituary

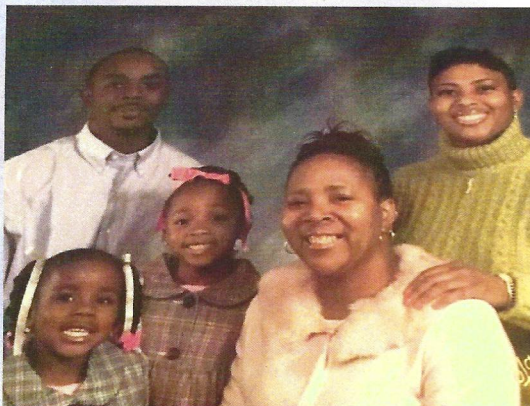
