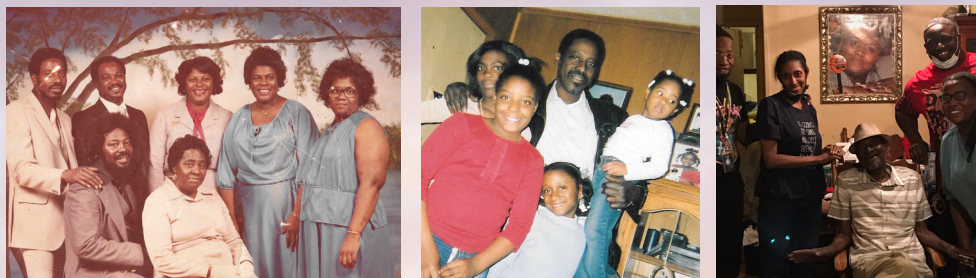


Precious Memories
