Loved by all who hold me dear.

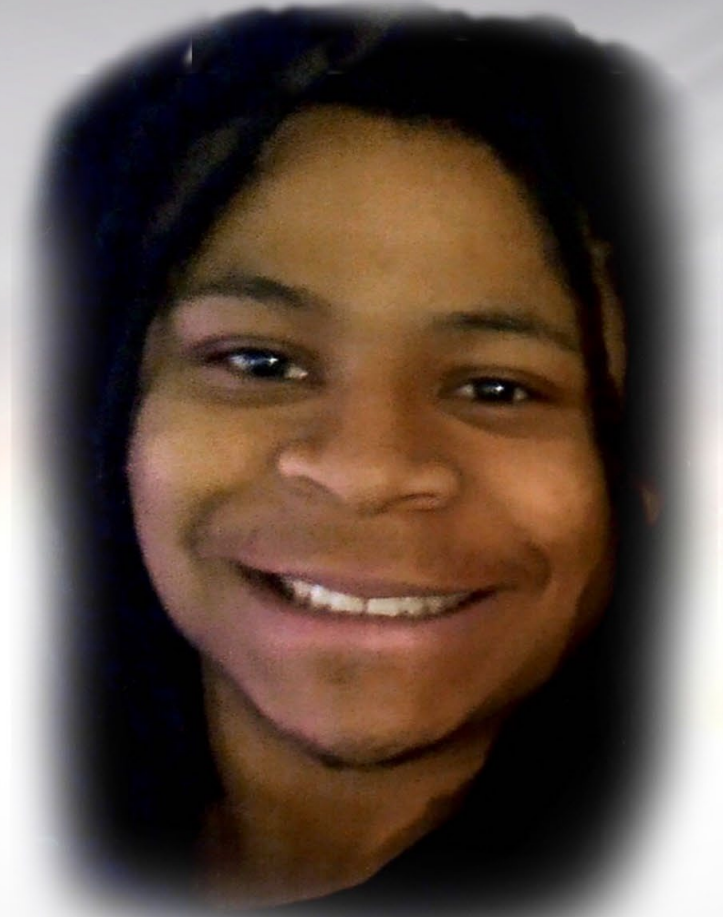
I hope you'll find your smile,
