Reflection of Life

Demetrius Foy, the son of Sherey Foy and Donald Ray Foy Sr., was born June 20, 1973, in Brooklyn, NY. He was called to eternal rest on Saturday, May 2, 2020.

He attended Trinity Baptist Church in Newark, New Jersey.

He was a 1991 graduate of Westside High School, Newark, New Jersey, where his was an outstanding member of the football team and the chorus. He then matriculated to Berkley College in Caldwell, New Jersey, where he received a degree in Business Administration and Management. He also attended a technical school to refine his mechanic trade and Star Career Academy to pursue a career as a surgical technician.

While doing his infamous mechanic work, he worked for Aerotek as a contractor for Bombardier and eventually went to work for NETJETS Aviation.

We lost our dearly departed Demetrius to the COVID-19 virus after a month-long battle in the ICU of Hackettstown Medical Center due to acute respiratory failure. Demetrius was outgoing, diligent, protective, altruistic, charismatic, and more than knowledgeable about a vast majority of topics.
