## The Obituary

*Jacquelyn Renee' Glover* of Washington, DC departed this life on Monday, February 6, 2023 at the age of forty eight. She was born June 10, 1974, in Albany, New York to the late Major (Ret.) As an adult and upon relocation to Washington, DC, she joined First Baptist Church of Glen Arden in Upper Marlboro, Maryland.

Jacquelyn attended the Child Development Learning Center and Felton Laboratory School on the campus of South Carolina State College (University). After graduating from Orangeburg Wilkinson High School, she attended North Carolina A&T State University, Greensboro, NC and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Architectural Engineering. Additional educational pursuits include a Business Leadership Development Certificate from John Hopkins University, Baltimore, MD, and a Master of Science degree in Engineering/Construction Engineering Management, from The Catholic University of America, Washington, DC.

Jacquelyn spent 26 years working on several types of engineering and architectural project. She served in the construction realm in leadership roles such as: principal (CEO), partner, managing director, project manager, senior facilities engineer, as well as architectural engineering coordinator for private and public sector clients. She was a business development professional and a construction manager at heart.
