At an early age, he confessed Christ and united with Bethel No. 1 Missionary Baptist Church in Opelika, Alabama.

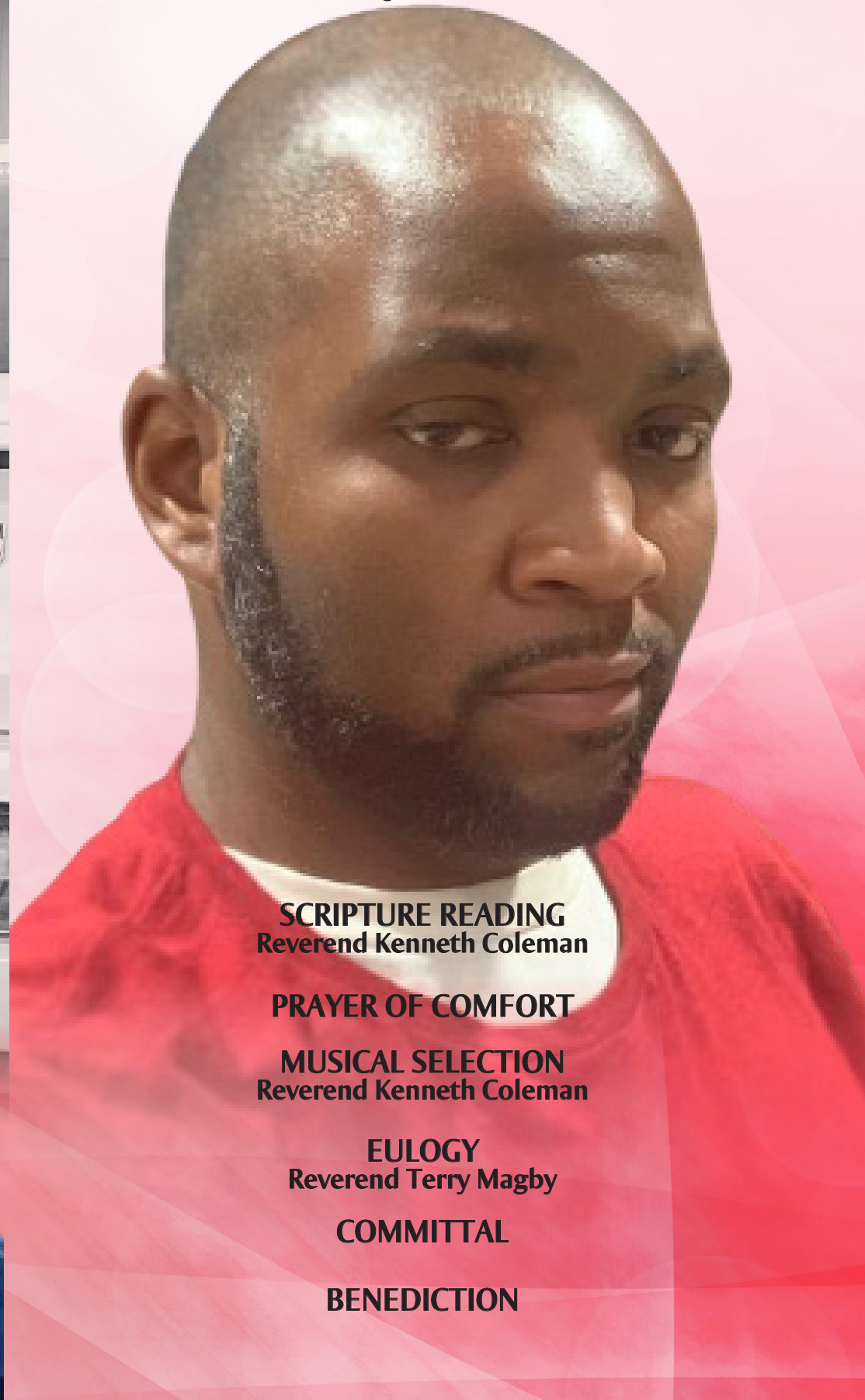
