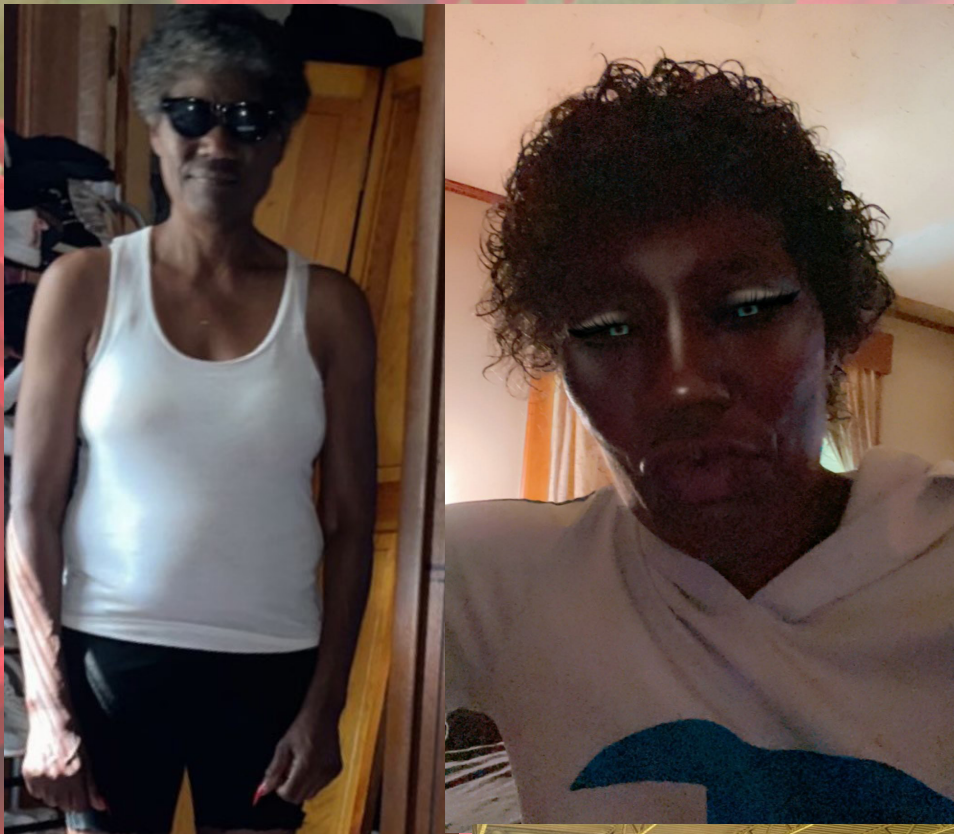
*- The Obituary -*
