## - The World's Best Uncle -

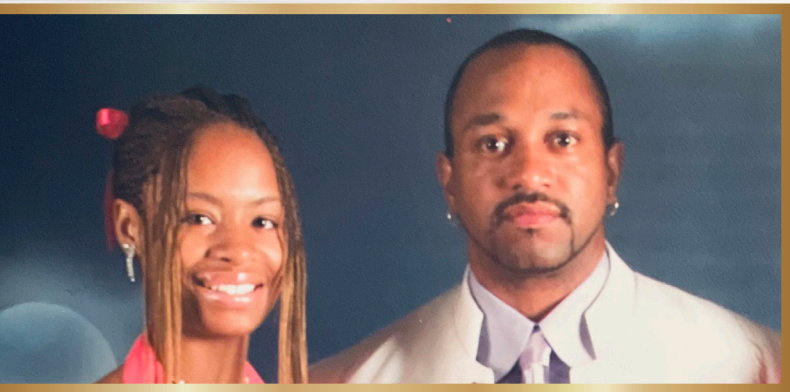
