- Obituary -

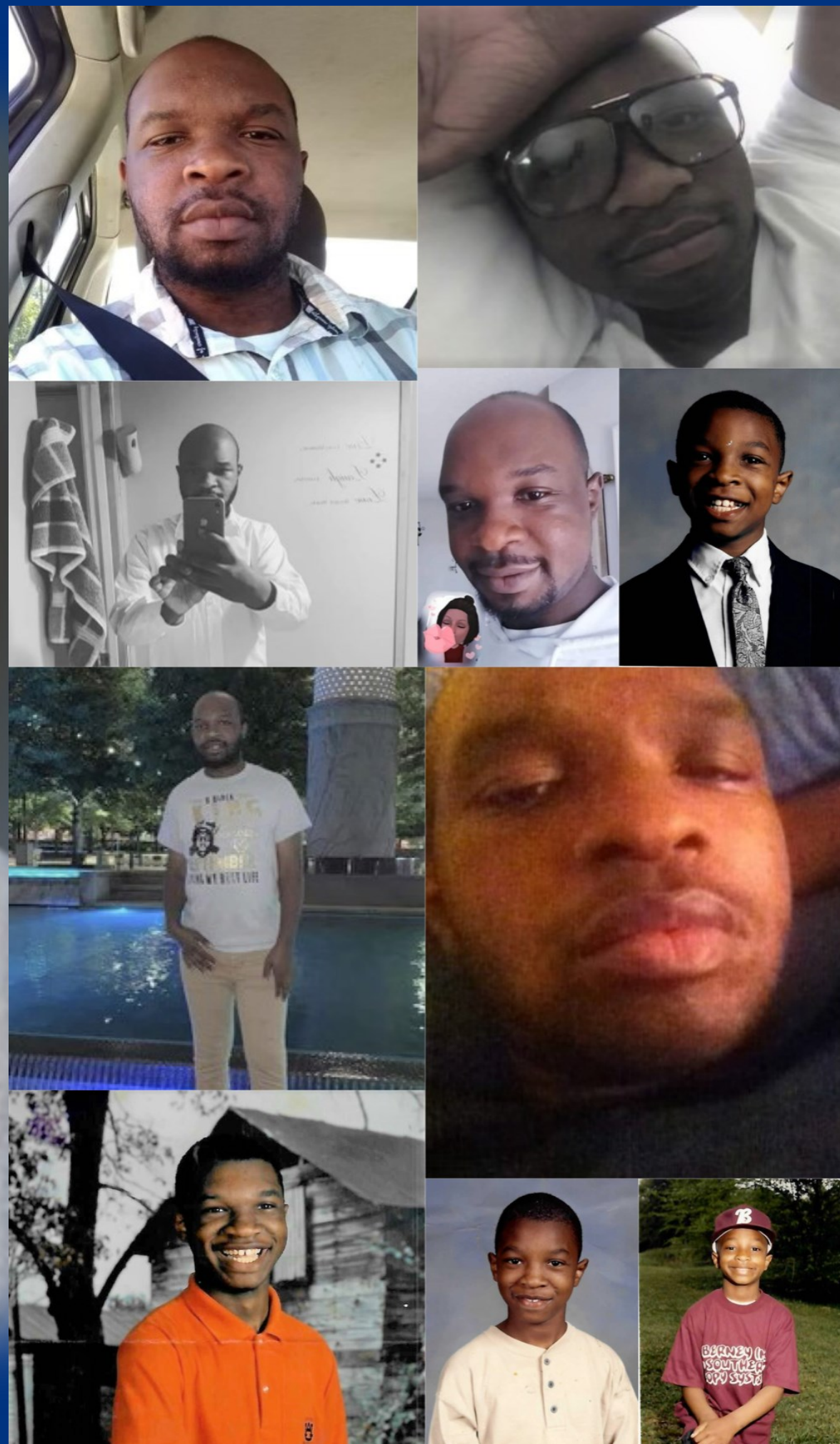
