Well In My Conclusion.



Life Legacy Obituary

Bishop James Franklin is a native of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and the fifth sibling born to Janie Mae and Eugene Franklin. In 1959, at the age of nineteen, he gave his life to Christ in the City of Oakland Park, Florida under the leadership of Elder Arthur Hall.

At the age of twenty, he married and had two daughters, Bridgett, and Lisa. He was also ordained as an Elder in the Church of God in Christ under the leadership of Elder Rayfield Showers later that same year. Although, he became an ordained Elder he did not continue to follow the Lord whole-heartedly. Therefore, his marriage suffered and ended in divorce. In 1972, he married Ruby Bellamy of Fort Lauderdale, Florida and kids Tony and Ericka from that union. James Franklin, Jr. was born. In 1973, Bishop James Franklin was restored back to the Lord in the Church of God in Christ, under the leadership of Pastor Luscious Carter of Speight Temple in Oakland Park, Florida. In October 1978, while in intercessory prayer, the Lord led him to Nationwide Holiness Church of Brotherly Love under the leadership of Bishop Leslie and Evangelist Christina Alexander. One month later, he was appointed as Assistant Pastor. In 1991, he was voted in as Pastor, after the passing of Bishop Leslie Alexander.


In 1996, he was ordained Overseer and Bishop of the Church's organization. Bishop James Franklin ordained the first woman in the organization as an Elder on February 16, 2006. He also installed the first woman, Elder Ruby Franklin, as Pastor of the church on March 11, 2007.

He was the Overseer of four churches: Nationwide Holiness Church of Brotherly Love under the leadership of Bishop Dr. Ruby Franklin and Union Outreach Ministry of Miami, Florida under the leadership of Bishop Willie and Pastor JoAnn Greene and New Liberty Ministry of West Park Florida under the leadership of Pastor Tony Cooper and International Prayer Center "IPC" Apostle Priscilla McCray
