He attended the Elementary School in Edison, GA and he was a 1961 graduate of the H.T Singleton High School of Morgan, GA shortly. After graduating he became a professional farm worker, there was no job too small or too hard for him. He worked as a logger, and at Edison Textile Company. In later years. he became an employee at the Edison, Gin Co. where he retired as a Truck driver.
