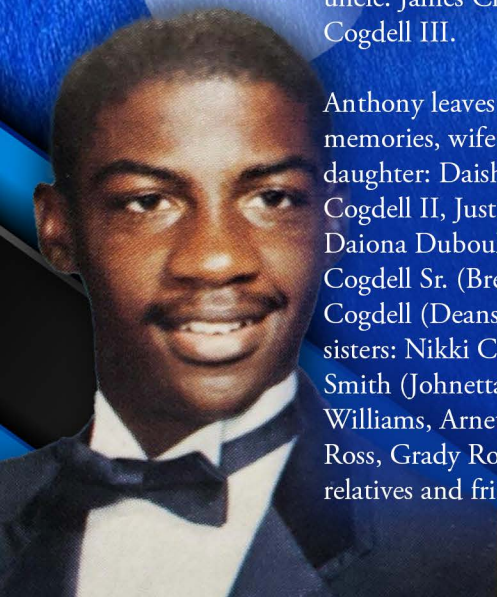
OBITUARY
